Tenth Year for Camp **SMILE** was **SUPER** Successful!

Camp SMILE (Sharing Memories in a Loving Environment) marked its 10th year with big changes: a new location, new theme, a surprise guest and record breaking attendance! Camp SMILE 2016 was held April 29-May 1 at Camp Lyons in Salt Lick. Staff chose this location due to the growth of the camp in 2015 with campers and volunteers. This year 115 people were hosted for the weekend, including 58 campers!

Camp SMILE had a superhero theme with a camper motto of “The Power to Defeat Grief Lies Within!” This included superhero challenges, games, crafts and even a visit from Batman himself! Batman came Saturday afternoon in his Hope-mobile with a message of hope, courage and kindness for the campers.



The camp focused on defining grief, coping skills and addressing the emotions one may feel after a death. Throughout the weekend, campers participated in many healing/coping activities such as: a balloon release with a letter to their loved one, a luminary ceremony, superhero mason jars, special memory pillow cases, creating worry dolls and participating in small groups. SCR Hospice Chaplains Michael Anderson and Jesse Perry held sessions titled “Ask the Chaplain,” while Shelly Irving, SCR Palliative Care PA-C, held an “Ask the PA” session. Campers also had opportunity to participate in activities such as archery, canoeing, dance and karaoke. This year, Camp SMILE also had a therapy dog, Lisa, who was a huge hit with the kids.

It is a true gift to the community; there is no charge for the camp and children receive a T-shirt, backpack and bereavement resources.
