Don Carpenter, Certified Pharmacy Tech, recently won the International Education Exchange (IEE) competition for his presentation on "BMV and the Road to Success." Barcode Medication Verification (BMV) is the process now used by SCR staff who administer medication to verify correct drug, dose, route and time as a safety feature. The process also documents the dose administration in the electronic medical record, and generates a charge for Financial Services.

IEE is a sponsored program by Medical Users Software Exchange (MUSE). The IEE competition is held at the annual MUSE International conference. Applicants submit their presentation for review to the MUSE board members where they are judged on professionalism and how useful the information would be to the overseas counterparts. Once the judges have made their votes, the CEO tallies the results and the top five finalists are selected and judged during the MUSE International conference. The winner of the IEE competition is selected to present their presentation at the European conference.
