FREE SMOKING CESSATION COURSES

St. Claire Regional will be providing **FREE** smoking cessation courses for anyone interested in quitting the use of tobacco products. **Cooper/Clayton classes will begin on Tuesday, August 5. For added convenience, there will be two classes offered every Tuesday for 13 weeks, one from 12:00 – 1:00 pm and one from 5:30 – 6:30 pm.** You can choose to attend either class. Cooper/Clayton classes will be held in room 224 (across from the cafeteria) located on the second floor of the hospital.

Cooper/Clayton is free of charge to anyone wishing to quit smoking, chewing or using tobacco products. Rowan County residents who sign up and attend classes will receive nicotine patches for free. You do not have to quit using tobacco products at the first session.
