Horizon Health to Manage SCR's Inpatient and Outpatient Behavioral Health Services

St. Claire Regional has contracted Horizon Health to manage inpatient and outpatient behavioral health services beginning Monday, January 7. Horizon Health will provide direct onsite management, outcomes measurement, physician recruiting, referral tracking software, clinical program redesign, policies and procedures, and staff competency training for SCR's inpatient and outpatient behavioral health service line.

The current 20 bed adult psychiatric unit will become 2 units - a 10 bed adult and a 10 bed Gero-psychiatric unit. The GeroPsych unit will accept more medically complex patients (65 yrs +). Horizon will be hiring an onsite, permanent program director for SCR that will report to Karen Holifield, VP Post-Acute Care Services.

Horizon Health was founded in 1981 and its primary business is the provision of quality psychiatric contract management services to general hospitals. The company currently maintains affiliations with 100+ hospitals in 36 states, many of them are small rural hospitals. It is the oldest and largest psychiatric management company.
