Every parent eagerly watches their child grow and develop; anticipating when each milestone will be met. Got first tooth, check. Introduced solid food, check. Slept through the night, check. Measured at the 75th percentile, check. Each right-of-passage reassures parents that their child is happy, healthy and growing as they should be.

But, what if a child doesn't seem to be keeping pace on the milestone timeline? First, parents should not panic. Every child is a unique individual and every child's growth and development will be equally unique. The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) divides developmental milestones into four areas: emotional, communication, problem-solving and physical. A child can easily be advanced in one area and behind in another, while still being a completely normal child.

If you are concerned about any aspect of your child's development speak to his/her pediatrician or primary care provider. You are most familiar with your child's skills and behavior, and can be vital in identifying issues.

St. Claire Regional Pediatric Therapy is dedicated to helping children participate in life to their fullest potential and developing the skills they need to become functional, independent adults. SCR Pediatric Therapy provides thorough evaluations and individualized therapy by physical, occupational and speech therapists with pediatric-specific certifications. Your child may benefit from physical, occupational or speech therapy if they have trouble:

- Learning how to crawl or walk
- Sitting or standing without support
- Walking up and down stairs
- Catching or throwing objects
- Playing at the same physical skill level as their peers
- With balance or coordination
- Spinning, rocking or rubbing objects excessively
- Using tools for writing or feeding
- Adjusting to new environments or sensations such as sounds, touch or movement
- Tolerating the taste or texture of foods
- Learning how to speak or have a limited use of words
- Pronouncing words so that others can understand

All participants received free nicotine replacement products, education and support to help them make the journey from smoker to non-smoker. The nicotine supplements were provided through a KY-ASAP grant and Rowan County Health Department. At the end of the program, the participants each received a gift and a certificate of achievement. Overall program evaluations were very positive and a monthly smoking cessation support group meeting will continue the first Tuesday of every month at 5:30 pm beginning February 5th in the St. Claire Regional Telemedicine area on the second floor.

St. Claire Regional Employee Health has a small amount of nicotine supplements available at no cost to staff, provided you sign up and attend the Cooper/ Clayton Smoking Cessation Classes.
