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St. Claire Regional Celebrates 50 Year Historical Milestone with the Morehead - Rowan County Chamber of Commerce, INC

Hospital pioneers would be so proud today

St. Claire Regional Medical Center has produced a 15-minute video celebration of its 50th anniversary of service to residents of Rowan and 10 other area counties.

Members of the Morehead-Rowan County Chamber of Commerce were treated to a showing of the video at Thursday's luncheon meeting.

The production was greeted with tears and cheers as old and new images flooded twin screens at the CHER building.

Precious photos, old newspaper clippings and personal recollections of those who were there at the beginning on July 1, 1963, rekindled the names and faces of community leaders, living and deceased, who helped make it a reality.

The names roll forth like a "Who's Who" in the history of this community and its hospital – Dr. C. Louise Caudill, Susie Halbleib, Sister Jeanne Francis Cleves, Dr. Warren Proudfoot, Mayor Bill Layne, Dr. Adron Doran, Alpha Hutchinson, Dr. Richard Carpenter, Dr. Hunter Black, J. Roger Caudill, W. E. Crutcher, Dr. Ewell Scott, Mark Neff, the Sisters of Notre Dame and many, many others.

The guests saw evidence of the Northeast Kentucky Hospital Foundation, a community-based group that helped with early finances and the recruitment of medical practitioners.

St. Claire literally began as a 41-bed, general acute care hospital with nine nurses and six physicians representing three specialties – general practice, surgery and internal medicine.

Today, 50 years later, it serves as a 159-bed regional referral medical center with more than 100 physicians in 31 different medical specialties.

Family practice medicine clinics in Morehead and four other communities make St. Claire accessible to more than 160,000 residents of Northeast Kentucky.

SCR is an established training site for the UK College of Medicine's Rural Physician Leadership (RPLP) Program which is designed to encourage new physicians to practice in rural areas.

The RPLP mission is amazingly close to the vision shared by those civic leaders 50 years ago.

In our opinion, those visionaries who helped make this community's hospital dream come true were that far ahead of their time.

Hospital CIOs Want More Time for Meaningful Use

St. Claire Regional CIO Randy McCleese, along with three other healthcare CIO's traveled to Washington, D.C. to present their concerns about the combination of increasingly rigorous demands and shorter deadlines in Meaningful Use Stage 2.

McCleese pointed to funding as a primary concern, saying that small and rural hospitals already make ends meet on "razor-thin margins."

"Capital," he added, "is hardly available for those items that provide direct patient care."

"The difficulty in achieving Meaningful Use, beyond the new, more complex objectives, is compounded by the short timeframes allowed for hospitals to implement 2014 certified EHRs," he said, according to a CHIME announcement.

A majority of hospital CIOs recently polled by healthsystemCIO.com in late May called the Meaningful Use program flawed, agreeing with CHIME's request for a one-year extension. CHIME's proposal came in response to a call in April from six GOP senators to reboot the Meaningful Use incentive program.

St. Claire Regional ranks as one of the top 5 safest hospitals in Kentucky to have surgery according to Consumer Reports new hospital surgery ratings. “Your safer-surgery survival guide”, published by Consumer Reports in July 2013, rated hospitals to help consumers find the right place to have surgery. “Our surgery ratings give patients more information so that they can make informed choices before surgery,” stated John Santa, M.D., M.P.H., medical director of Consumer Reports. “We hope that by highlighting performance differences, we can motivate hospitals to improve.”

Consumer Reports used ratings for the 2,463 U.S. acute-care or critical-access hospitals with sufficient Medicare fee-for-service in-patient surgical claims data from patients 65 and older.
