St. Claire opened its doors on July 1, 1963, as a general acute care hospital with 41 beds, 9 nurses and 6 physicians representing 3 medical specialties (General Practice, Surgery and Internal Medicine).

Today, St. Claire is much more than just a hospital, it's an integrated healthcare system known as St. Claire HealthCare.

St. Claire HealthCare (SCH) is the largest employer in the region with over 1,300 staff members including more than 100 medical providers representing 32 medical specialties. It includes the largest rural hospital in Northeastern Kentucky with 159 beds, 7 family medicine locations located within 5 counties, a multi-specialty medical pavilion, an outpatient center, homecare services and operates 3 retail services including family medical supply, pharmacy and aesthetics.

SCH also partners with UK HealthCare to offer services at the Morehead Cancer Treatment Center and Morehead Women's HealthCare.

SCH serves as an established training site for the UK College of Medicine's Rural Physician Leadership Program.

ABOUT MOREHEAD

Morehead is located in Rowan County, Kentucky, situated on I-64 in the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains and nestled in the heart of the Daniel Boone National Forest.

Morehead serves as the economic and cultural hub of the region. Servicing over 100,000 people in health care, education and recreation, the town is home to both a top-ranked university and a comprehensive community and technical college. A combination of locally owned and chain restaurants offer a variety of dining options. Plus, numerous arts and music festivals, including the Cave Run Storytelling Festival and the Art & Eats Festival, draw visitors throughout the year.

The area features a low cost of living, low real-estate taxes and a variety of housing opportunities. In addition to established neighborhoods and new housing developments, farmland and rural housing options are available.

ROWAN COUNTY SCHOOLS

The Rowan County School System is made up of six schools—four elementary schools, one middle school and one high school. Educational needs are met in a variety of ways: through enrichment within the regular classroom, advanced placement courses and early college courses in collaboration with Morehead State University.

Private schooling opportunities are also available through three private, parochial schools: Lakeside Christian Academy, Rowan Christian Academy and Farmers Christian Academy.

MOREHEAD STATE UNIVERSITY

Morehead State University has been recognized for 14 consecutive years as one of the top public universities in the south. The university offers over 200 degree programs on the two-year, four-year and graduate levels.

The university has an enrollment of more than 10,500 students representing 115 Kentucky counties, 46 states and 28 nations. Over 70% of the faculty hold doctoral degrees, and the student-faculty ratio is 18 to 1.

CAVE RUN LAKE

Beautiful Cave Run Lake, an 8,270-acre recreational lake located within minutes of Morehead in the Daniel Boone National Forest, hosts some of the best muskie fishing in the United States.

The lake has two campgrounds with nearly 400 campsites for both RV and tent camping. Twelve boat ramps are located on the lake, and hiking trails provide miles of exploration. Enthusiasts return time and time again to this exciting, yet relaxing environment offering fun-filled adventures to people of all ages.
