Caren L. Daniels-Thacker, MD, St. Claire HealthCare emergency physician and associate chief medical officer for hospital based services, has been appointed by Governor Matt Bevin to the Kentucky State Board of Medical Licensure.

"I am honored that Governor Bevin appointed me and I look forward to serving Kentucky in this new capacity," said Daniels-Thacker.

The Kentucky Board of Medical Licensure is composed of 15 members, 11 of whom are appointed by the Governor. The Board is responsible for protecting the public by ensuring that only qualified medical and osteopathic physicians are licensed and initiating appropriate disciplinary action when violations of the Medical Practice Act occur. In addition, the Board regulates the practice of physician assistants, surgical assistants, athletic trainers and acupuncturists in the Commonwealth.

Daniels-Thacker serves as the regional EMS director for St. Claire HealthCare, and EMS medical director for Left Beaver Fire and Rescue, Morehead/Rowan County EMS, Elliott County EMS, Menifee County EMS, Morgan County EMS, Bath County EMS and Carter County EMS. Additionally, she serves on several boards and committees relating to the medical field and her expertise.

## Gilliam Earns Tumor Registrar Credential

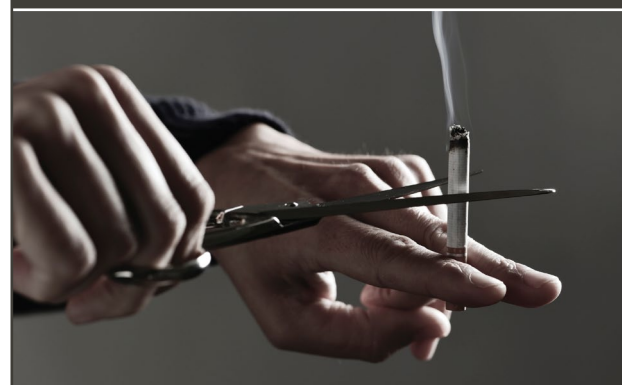
