Congressman Hal Rogers' field representative, Adam Rice, presented Mark with the Difference Maker award noting there are few people who go above and beyond to make a difference in the way we live, and Mark J. Neff is one of those great leaders in our region.

Mark also received the commission of Kentucky Colonel which is the highest title of honor bestowed by the Governor of Kentucky. Mark received the title in recognition of his noteworthy accomplishments and outstanding service to our community, state, and nation.
