St. Claire HealthCare and and NE KY AHEC Awarded \$200,000 Federal Opioid Planning Grant

St. Claire HealthCare, in collaboration with Northeast Kentucky Area Health Education Center (NE KY AHEC), was recently awarded a \$200,000 grant from the Health Resources & Services Administration (HRSA) to establish the Northeast Kentucky Opioid Crisis Response Consortium.

SCH/NE KY AHEC was one of eight Kentucky organizations – and 120 nationwide – to receive the Rural Communities Opioid Response Program-Planning grant.

In addition to SCH/NE KY AHEC, the regional consortium will bring together the Clark County Health Department, Tri-State Primary Care, the Kentucky Rural Healthcare Information Organization (KRHIO), and Comprehend Inc., to focus on prevention, treatment, and recovery related to opioid use disorder. The one-year project, which took effect June 1, targets the rural areas of Clark, Greenup, Lawrence, Mason, Nicholas, Powell, and Robertson counties.

Specifically, the consortium hopes to: expand treatment options, including access to medication-assisted treatment (MAT), by recruiting and training new opioid use disorder providers; reduce treatment costs for uninsured and underinsured patients who seek MAT or other treatment options; and enhance the involvement of peer recovery specialists in both clinical and non-clinical settings.

This new project will build on the efforts of the Northeast Kentucky Opioid Crisis Response Network, which was formed in August 2018 through a separate HRSA grant. The network, which targets St. Claire's 11-county service region, includes as partners SCH, the NE KY AHEC, Pathways Inc., the Gateway District Health Department, and Sterling Health Solutions Inc.

- All staff enrolled with SCH's Anthem Insurance Plan receive a discount on prescription copays.
- Copay discounts are only available for staff members. Please allow us to fill your family members' prescriptions as well. They are not eligible for staff only discounts, but will receive our price matching quarantee.
- SCH staff with SCH's Anthem Green & Blue Insurance Plans receive a 25% discount off prescription copays.
- SCH staff with SCH's Anthem Red Insurance Plan receive a 25% discount off prescription copays up to a maximum of \$15.
- We fill 90 day prescriptions and all staff with SCH's Anthem Insurance receive copay discounts on 90 day fills.

Staff will save money by switching their 90 day mail order prescriptions from Anthem's pharmacy (or any other pharmacy) to St. Claire's pharmacy. Example: \$20 copays become \$15. And, most prescriptions can be picked-up the same day.

- We offer price matching with all local competitors, such as Kroger, Rite Aid, Total Care, and Wal-Mart.
- In many cases, with medications that fall into the higher copay tiers, our pharmacy may be able to assist you in finding additional coupons from the manufacturer that will further reduce your cost.
- We also offer our staff special pricing on some common medications that are no longer covered by our insurance.

For example, loratadine can be purchased with a prescription for \$10 for a 90 day supply while cetirizine is currently \$24 for a 90 day supply.

- Enroll in our auto refill program and your prescriptions will automatically be refilled.
- Sign up for text alerts and get a text message when your prescriptions are ready for pick-up.
