St. Claire HealthCare (SCH) is an integrated healthcare system serving the people of Eastern Kentucky in an 11-county service region including Bath, Carter, Elliott, Fleming, Lewis, Magoffin, Menifee, Montgomery, Morgan, Rowan, and Wolfe counties.

SCH includes the largest rural hospital in Northeastern Kentucky with 159 beds, seven family medicine locations, specialty and subspecialty practices, home care services (home health, hospice, and palliative medicine), counseling services, and operates three retail services, including family medical supply, pharmacy, and aesthetics. In addition, we are an established training site for the UK School of Medicine’s Rural Physician Leadership Program, as well as partners with UK HealthCare to offer services at the Morehead Cancer Treatment Center and Morehead Women’s Healthcare.


