

DR. BARRET LESSENBERRY

ACCORDING TO THE VALUES OF THE TJ PLEDGE, WE ADAPT TO CHANGE BY:

- · Being a part of the solution when I am presented with a challenge
- Embracing change and set the example for those around me
- · Accepting openly when there are changes that TJ Regional and/or I have no control over
- Managing the expectations of others by explaining duration and next steps as often as needed.

Sabrina has and continues to exemplify characteristics of Change and is deserving of recognition for her efforts over the last 2+ years of the COVID pandemic. While drug shortages have posed many challenges over the last several years, the number and severity of drug shortages throughout the pandemic has been unprecedented and led to significant efforts by Pharmacy and other clinical staff to ensure that patient care is not negatively impacted. By nature of her role as the Pharmacy Buyer, Sabrina coordinates purchasing and drug shortage management for TJ pharmacies throughout the health-system. She actively tracks dozens of medications at any given point in time that are unavailable and in short supply for reasons beyond her control (manufacturer production issues, transportation delays, increased utilized due to COVID surge, etc.), and she has developed new processes for communicating drug shortages to ensure that alternatives are available. This often includes coordinating with multiple wholesaler suppliers and manufacturers to track down available supply and ensure that it's available to patients as soon as possible. Further, Sabrina has served as the primary inventory contact with Kentucky agencies related to COVID vaccine inventory and COVID treatment therapeutics. Although the distribution process for these medications continually changed throughout the pandemic, Sabrina worked closely with Pharmacy and TJ leadership to ensure these supplies were available and to maintain compliance with all required federal and state inventory reporting. For these reasons, please accept this nomination for her to be recognized for the manner she's embraced Change!

The Medical Staff Office has received numerous nominations about Dr. Barret Lessenberry for "Change". We are excited to share several examples that Dr. Lessenberry adapted to change and played a vital role in developing solutions.

The OR workflow was significantly interrupted due to the Cerner implementation that impacted volume capability in addition to alterations in day to day processes. Dr. Lessenberry has adapted to the change with strong leadership for the department in these adjustments.

Dr. Lessenberry has engaged with the training team members to improve functionality of the system. He has gone above and beyond to keep up with the EMR functionality in order to lead within the department and provide support for others. He has been a strong encourager to other medical staff during the EMR implementation especially when they are struggling to adapt to the changes.

Dr. Lessenberry has assisted department leadership as well as the outpatient clinic team to make necessary adjustments to processes that will improve productivity in surgery.
