RYAN WHITE MEDICAL CASE MANAGEMENT

The Ryan White Medical Case Management program is available free of charge, to individuals living with HIV /AIDS. Case Management is a client-centered program that links clients with health care and other services as needed. The primary goal of medical case management is to work with individuals to connect to and engage in their medical care.

Ryan White Medical Case Managers are located throughout the Kansas City area in a variety of community settings including local health departments, hospitals, health clinics and community-based organizations. Eligible clients may seek case management services through their medical provider or any agency where a case manager is located. Once a referral is received, a case manager will make arrangements to meet with the individual. These meetings can occur at the doctor's office, clinic, hospital, case manager's office or individual's home or place of work.

Case managers can help you navigate and understand the healthcare system by offering support and by being an active member of your medical team. Case managers can assist the client in locating and accessing services such as medical care, medications, mental health and substance abuse counseling and care, housing and other community resources. To enroll in services you must provide the following documentation: Proof of HIV-status, proof of income, and proof of residency, as well as documentation of any insurance plan, Medicaid, Medicare or VA benefits you might have. You also must be willing to meet with your case manager at least two times per year and participate in your medical care.

Eligibility requirements for services are based on where an individual lives, income and HIV status. Please contact a case manager for additional information on how Medical Case Management can help you. The next several pages list the addresses and contact information for case management sites throughout the Kansas City area.

Linkage to Care (LTC) Coordinators assist people who are newly diagnosed to access healthcare, affordable medications, mental health services, infectious disease specialists, peer education and other basic needs. LTC is a short term program (90 days). After LTC service, you may chose to graduate to self-support or long term Ryan White Case Management.

PRIMARY CARE

PATIENT + PROVIDER=PARTNERSHIP IN CARE

In order to receive the best possible healthcare, it is important for patients and healthcare providers to develop an ongoing relationship. This partnership requires work from both the patient and the provider. Some information to keep in mind when working with your provider:

- Keep a notebook with dates and results of tests
- Keep a list of current medications, as well as medications you have taken in the past
- Write down any problems or questions you want to discuss with your provider at your appointment
- Keep your appointments or let your provider know if you need to re-schedule
- Tell your provider whenever you are not sure about certain instructions. If you do not ask, your
 provider will assume that you understand
- Invite a family member, friend, peer educator, case manager or other advocate to accompany you to your appointment
- Write down dates and where you went for specialty care. Try to get a business card from your
 specialist to give your provider for your health records. Also, remind the specialist to send a report
 to your primary care provider.

To ensure that you are receiving the very best HIV care talk to your provider about how often you need to schedule an appointment and what labwork or tests should be done. The following is a basic guideline to discuss with your provider:

- Provider visit every 4-6 months
- CD4 cell count once per year unless newly diagnosed, then every six months x 3. HIV Viral load every 6 months. May be more often if you are starting or changing HIV medications.
- Tuberculosis skin test once a year
- Screening for STD's once a year
- Screening for Hepatitis A, B, and C once a year

PATIENT + PROVIDER=PARTNERSHIP IN CARE

- Blood test for cholesterol and lipids once a year
- Dental/oral exam once a year
- Eye/vision exam once a year
- Women: pap smear once a year

You will also need:

- Flu shot every year
- Pneumovax every 5 years
- Tetanus/diphtheria every 10 years
- Hepatitis A and Hepatitis B vaccinations
