Humane Society of Greater Kansas City:

Open to anyone who qualifies and lives in the Kansas City metro area. Must fill out form showing need (anyone on government assistance, Social Security, or meeting WIC poverty guidelines will qualify)

Spay and Neuter Kansas City:

Will need to provide proof of income within two weeks, copy of photo ID, proof that pets have been spayed/ neutered (if they haven't been, SNKC may be able to assist). If approved, will be required to have pet(s) current on rabies vaccination, city licensing, and microchipped. These services are provided at SNKC

STARelief does not donate to anyone breeding, selling or flipping animals and it reserves the right to refuse anyone under any circumstance, such as someone who is a breeder. Below are the general guidelines. However, every request will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. STARelief will provide food for up to five pets per household.
