Planning

- 1. Choose a nonprofit organization serving the basic needs of others. Nonprofit list included.
- 2. Contact your chosen nonprofit to determine what needs they have for your Caring Drive or Volunteer Day.
- 3. Return the Community of Caring Participant Form to jennifer.skinner@unity-health.org
- 4. For Caring Drives, plan an accessible drop-off location in a safe place for collected items.
- 5. Decide if you want t-shirts and place your order. T-shirt information and form emailed after the Participant Form is returned. <u>Please Note:</u> Your group is responsible for ordering and making payment if you decide to purchase Community of Caring T-shirts.

Communicating

- □ Communicate the purpose of your Caring Drive/Volunteer Day so others understand the need.
- □ Inform your group of the items and dates for collection and/or Volunteer Day.
- □ Hang flyers around your organization. (Emailed after Participant Form is returned).
- Put out your yard sign and/or window cling. (Will be delivered to your location mid-August).
