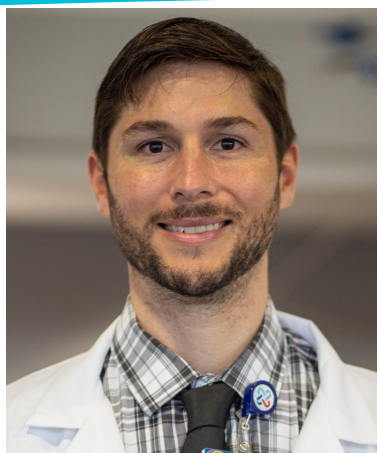
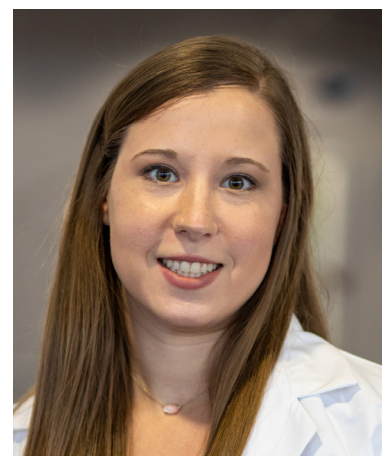


Pharmacy Residents 2020
