Gold Coast Health Plan (GCHP) would like to share the following resource available to providers:

The American Cancer Society (ACS) is hosting a 2025 HPV Vaccination Health System Learning Community, which is a dynamic initiative aimed at increasing HPV vaccination rates among adolescents 9 to 13 years of age in select states with the largest adolescent populations. Members of this cohort will dive into evidence-based interventions, unlock data-driven strategies, explore cutting-edge quality improvement (QI) practices, and engage in meaningful discussions with peers to make a real impact.

An informational session will be held on Thursday, April 24, 2025, with sessions beginning in May. The learning community is free, and five sessions will be held virtually via Zoom, with the last session taking place in December.

Health systems will have the opportunity to:

- Implement QI tools & evidence-based interventions
- Learn about the latest scientific evidence
- Network with peer organizations
- Engage in a culture of continuous QI
- Explore ACS and ACS National HPV Roundtable resources and materials
