Physical exams are important to identify any complications or issues and serve as an opportunity to offer any additional needed resources. Gold Coast Health Plan's (GCHP) Health Education (HE) Department has many resources for expecting mothers and new parents, including pregnancy and postpartum packets. These packets include the state Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) Newborn Referral Form, information on nutrition, immunizations, and many other resources.

GCHP also offers <u>online resources</u> for members. Members can sign up to receive a <u>pregnancy</u> and/or <u>new parent</u> e-newsletter, with information about stages of pregnancy, and updates about growth and behavior of their baby. GCHP's online <u>health library</u> includes short videos and interactive tools, available in English and Spanish.
