The RISE Grant Program seeks to measurably improve the quality of and access to medical and behavioral health care for the GCHP Medi-Cal population in Ventura County. In 2026, the program seeks to proactively prepare providers and community partners to help Medi-Cal members navigate upcoming eligibility and engagement requirements, which are scheduled to begin in 2027, with the goal of minimizing coverage disruptions, improving member experience, and promoting continuity of care.

This may include provider- and community-led initiatives that help members:

- Maintain Medi-Cal coverage.
- Avoid administrative disenrollment.
- Successfully complete renewal requirements.
- Connect to qualifying work, training, education, or community engagement activities through culturally and linguistically appropriate navigation, community or volunteer programs and opportunities, and educational support.
