	Harm Reduction Education Nurses can provide this.	Safer Use Strategies Avoid using alone to reduce risk of fatal overdose. Start with a small amount esp. when using a new supply. Use sterile equipment, syringe exchange programs. Rotate injection sites to prevent infection. Don't mix substances, especially opioids and depressants like alcohol or benzodiazepines. Use fentanyl test strips. Overdose Prevention Educate on overdose signs and response: slowed breathing, unconsciousness, etc. Distribute naloxone (Narcan) and train clients and families on how to use it. Encourage creating an overdose safety plan, especially with polydrug use.	 Infection Prevention Discuss safe sex practices (condoms, regular testing). Promote vaccination (Hep A, Hep B, and HPV). Provide wound care education for people who inject drugs. Refer for HIV and Hep C screening, PrEP/PEP access, or STI treatment as needed. Safer Storage & Disposal Safe storage of substances and paraphernalia away from children and pets. Safe disposal of needles / sharps; inform about community disposal sites or drop boxes.
