On Oct. 1, 2025, Gold Coast Health Plan (GCHP) will be launching a Dual Special Needs Plan (D-SNP) – also known as a “Medi Medi” plan – for those with both Medi-Cal and Medicare benefits and will begin serving new members on Jan. 1, 2026.

GCHP has scheduled a series of general training sessions covering Medicare and Medicare Advantage to help providers gain a foundational understanding of the product GCHP will begin offering to members starting next month.

In Oct. 2025, we will be hosting a second round of webinars focused specifically on GCHP’s new D-SNP. These sessions will provide insight into program structure, member benefits, and operational expectations.
