Community Support	Description	Eligible Population
Housing Transition Navigation Services	Developing member housing plan and assistance with obtaining housing, including assistance with searching for housing or completing housing applications.	 Homeless / at risk of homelessness AND at least one of the following: One or more serious chronic conditions Serious Mental Illness (SMI) / Substance Use Disorder (SUD) At risk of institutionalization Serious Emotional Disturbance (SED) (children / adolescents), OR Exiting incarceration Transitional-aged youth with significant barriers to housing (juvenile justice involvement, one or more convictions, SMI/SUD/SED, welfare system involvement, and victims of trafficking / family violence)
Housing Deposits*	Funding for one-time services necessary to establish a household, including security deposits to obtain a lease, first month's coverage of utilities, or first and last month's rent required prior to occupancy.	
Housing Tenancy and Sustaining Services	Assistance with maintaining stable tenancy once housing is secured, including interventions for behaviors that may jeopardize housing, such as late rental payment or behaviors resulting from unaddressed behavioral health conditions. Interventions may include financial literacy support; coordination with the member's ECM provider, behavioral health providers, and other providers; and/or landlord relationship management services.	
Recuperative Care (Medical Respite)	Short-term residential care for beneficiaries who no longer require hospitalization but still need to recover from injury or illness and whose condition would be exacerbated by an unstable living environment.	 Members who are at risk of hospitalization or post hospitalization, AND at least one of the following: Are homeless or at risk of homelessness Live alone with no formal supports Housing insecurity jeopardizing their health and safety
Medically Tailored Meals	Meals provided to members that are tailored to meet their unique dietary needs, within 30 days following discharge from a hospital.	Members discharged from the hospital within the past 30 days who were hospitalized for a Congestive Heart Failure (CHF)-related primary diagnosis
