Re: California Executive Order on Russian Sanctions

Date: Sept. 1, 2022

Executive Order (EO) N-6-22, issued by Gov. Gavin Newsom earlier this year, requires all agencies that are subject to the Governor's authority to notify contractors of their obligations to comply with the sanctions imposed by the U.S. government and the state of California in response to Russia's attacks on Ukraine.

Gold Coast Health Plan (GCHP) is issuing this memo as notice that as a contractor, you are required to comply with these sanctions, including but not limited to, the federal executive orders identified in the above mentioned EO, as well the sanctions identified on the <u>U.S. Department of Treasury website</u>. Failure to comply may result in the termination of contracts.
