Deadline: Monday, April 23, 2018 at 5 p.m.

Submit a student-created video for kindergarteners through sixth-graders to watch before attending our School Series shows. We'll feature the winning video on our website during the 2018–2019 school year.

We'll also acknowledge the winning school, student group or student organization on social media. All students involved in creating the winning video will receive a certificate of excellence—and a surprise party at their school or organization.

Videos should be about three minutes long and highlight these 10 theater etiquette rules:

1. Plan to arrive 30–45 minutes before your School Series show starts.
2. Gum, food, drinks and candy are not allowed in the theater during the show.
3. Always stay with your group and wait for the ushers to take you to your seat. If you need to use the restroom, go before being seated.
4. Turn off your cell phone, watch alarm or anything else that can make noise or light up, disturbing the performers and audience.
5. Try to stay still once you're seated. You can't get up and move around during the show.
6. The theater lights will dim and then go dark right before the show starts. Sit calmly and quietly at this time.
7. Do not talk or whisper during the show, and only laugh at appropriate times. Performers can hear you, which is very distracting.
8. Do not take pictures or videos.
9. Show your appreciation by clapping at the end of the show. Performers love to hear applause!
10. After the show ends and performers take their final bow, stay in your seat and wait patiently for your group's turn to exit the theater.

- > Keep your video around three minutes long for an audience of kindergarteners through sixth-graders
- > Post your video on YouTube or Vimeo so you can share the link
- > We must receive the following by **Monday, April 23, 2018 at 5 p.m.:**
 - Completed and signed application (filled out by teacher/adult overseeing the project)
 - Completed and signed photo release forms for all students involved in the project (filled out by students' parents/guardians)
 - Link to your video on YouTube or Vimeo

 - Signed and scanned documents are fine
