



## Gauchezco Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2018

Grape variety	100% Cabernet Sauvignon
Vineyard details	Barrancas-Maipú. Deep alluvial soils: clay, sand and limestone predominate. Drip irrigation. 55 years old vines.
Vine cultivation	Vertical shoot position trellising (VSP)
Harvest details	Hand picked in bins on the last week of March

### VINIFICATION

Grapes were destemmed and crushed. Maceration before fermentation for 48 hrs. 14 days of alcoholic fermentation. Natural malolactic fermentation.

Maturation: 15% of the wine spent 8 month in third use French and American oak barrels.

### TASTING NOTES

<b>Color</b>	This Cabernet Sauvignon has an intense and lively deep red purple color.
<b>Nose</b>	Fruity notes of pepper, raspberry, dry fig and raisins along with floral notes of violets.
<b>Palate</b>	Complex and harmonious wine, with a soft and velvety entry, firm tannins and lovely juicy finish.

*Enjoy it with smoked and grilled meats and prepared spicy meats.*
