Grape variety Vineyard details	100% Malbec Barrancas-Maipú. Deep alluvial soils: clay, sand and limestone predominate. Drip
Vine cultivation	irrigation. Vertical shoot position trellising (VSP)
Harvest details	Hand picked in bins from the second week of March

VINIFICATION

Grapes were destemmed and crushed. Maceration before fermentation for 48 hrs. 14 days of alcoholic fermentation. Natural malolactic fermentation.

Maturation: 15% of the wine spent 8 month in third use French and American oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Color	This Malbec has an intense and lively deep red purple color.
Nose	Fruity notes of plum, raspberry along with floral notes of violets.
Palate	Complex and harmonious wine, with a soft and velvety entry, firm tannins and lovely juicy finish.

Enjoy it with smoked and grilled red meats and pork. Also with pepper, sage, and creamy mushroom sauces.
