



## Gauchezco Reserve Red Blend 2017

Grape Variety	55% Malbec 25% Petit Verdot 20% Cabernet Franc
Vineyard Details	100% from Gauchezco vineyard in Barrancas, Maipú, Mendoza. 850 meters a.s.l. Barrancas soil is 50% sand, 30% limestone, 20% clay y 5% roks. Top soil depth 0,80 meters (2,90 ft).
Harvest details	Hand picked in cases in the last week of March

### VINIFICATION

Both wines are made separate and the is blended after the maturation in oak barrels.

Bunch selection, grapes were destemmed and crushed. Maceration before fermentation for 48 hrs. 12 days of alcoholic fermentation in small stainless steel tanks. Total maceration time of 24 days. Natural malolactic fermentation.

Maturation: 10 months in second and third use oak barrels: 60% French, 40% American.

### TASTING NOTES

<b>Color</b>	Ruby red with deep violet hues.
<b>Nose</b>	Intense and attractive aromas of red fruits, such as plumbs and blackberry and green pepper from the Cabernet Franc.
<b>Palate</b>	The mouth feel is sweet, persistent , profound and with a juicy finish.
