The Company intends to apply a portion of the funds to eligible payments under the Contract for **Lot 1 – Main Civil Works (Surface and Underground)**. Bidding is open to all eligible Nepalese Bidders.

 - a) Surface works associated with Intake, Head works (Barrage), Box Culvert, De-sanding Basin, Head-pond, Steel Conveyance Pipe Support Structures, Powerhouse, Tailrace, and all other associated civil works.
 - b) Underground works associated with Headrace Tunnel, Rock Trap, Surge Tank, Surge Shaft/Chamber, Adits, and other related underground civil structures.

6. Bids shall be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 14:00 Hours on [2083/03/16] at the office of the Company stated in Clause 3 above.
7. Bids shall remain valid for a period of One hundred twenty (120) days from the date of bid opening and must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of not less than NPR 15,000,000/- (Nepalese Rupees Fifteen Million Only). Bid bond shall be Unconditional bank guarantee issued by class "A" commercial bank of Nepal. In the event that the last date for purchasing, submission, or opening of bids falls on a Government holiday, the next working day shall automatically be deemed the valid date for the respective activity.
