APPLICATION PROCESS

Virtue is very proud to be able to offer a support programme, which aims to alleviate significant financial hardship in order to support our Virtue members to continue their participation within our club. Current individual members can apply for support funding across all disciplines, with no preference given to those in squads. The amount of support awarded is assessed on a case by case basis and will only be valid for the following quarter. You must be a member of Virtue to apply for support and have read the criteria thoroughly.

- ALL SECTIONS OF THE ONLINE APPLICATION FORM MUST BE COMPLETED IN ORDER FOR AN APPLICATION TO BE CONSIDERED.
- PLEASE NOTE: SUPPORT APPLICATIONS ARE REVIEWED EACH QUARTER.
- ONLY SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS WILL BE NOTIFIED OF THE OUTCOME OF THEIR APPLICATION IN DUE COURSE.

CRITERIA

Aim of support at Virtue to alleviate significant financial hardship

- For the purpose of the Virtue Support Scheme, we define significant financial hardship as being a shortage of finances which has the effect of ending people's involvement in our sport, or makes it unreasonably difficult for people to continue to be involved.
- Current members of Virtue who are experiencing financial difficulty which is affecting their continued involvement in our sport are eligible, or those who are in crisis.
- Those who are deemed to be financially capable of/or have the means to fund their involvement in our sport are not eligible at this time.
- Any person who has made a falsified claim in the past will not be eligible.
- The management team may also ask Virtue staff members to verify applications.
- Support grants cannot be used to pay BG membership subscriptions.
- Support grants cannot be used to pay travel expenses.
- Support grants cannot be used to pay for kit.
- Support grants cannot be awarded retrospectively.
- Normally if you have received one grant you will not be eligible for another 12 months .
- We will only consider applications where the applicant has been participating at the club for more than one quarter.
- In case of injury which may have long-term effect on health, we will request a letter of medical evidence to support this.
- If there has been no response from the club by the date of the following quarter's support application, then your application unfortunately has not been successful.
- If a grant recipient fails to respond to a request for feedback, then a second application for a grant will not be considered.

You must be a member of Virtue for at least a quarter to apply for the Support Grant and have read the criteria.

All sections of the online application form must be completed in full for an application to be considered.

Once your application form is complete your application will be sent to the management panel for review.

Please note: Support Grants are reviewed every quarter.

Only successful applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application.
