

Barcode Plus™ | Handwritten

The Barcode Plus™ | Handwritten Blood Band has plenty of space for handwriting patient information and includes a shield for protection. The large Blood Bank ID (BBID) makes it quick and easy to check, and the barcodes allow more efficiency in capturing the BBID in your Laboratory Information System (LIS).



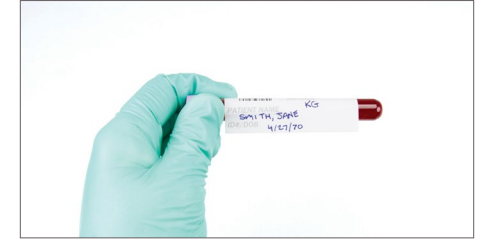
- 1. VERIFY** the patient's identity.
WRITE the patient's information over the prompts on the band using a ballpoint pen.
NOTE: Do not apply the shield over handwritten information at this time.



- 2. WRAP** the band tail around the patient's extremity to size.
SNAP the button closure to secure.
CUT the excess band tail material with scissors.



- 3. DRAW** the pre-transfusion specimen per your protocol.
PEEL the handwritten patient information label from band.



- 4. PLACE** the handwritten patient information label on the specimen tube lengthwise.



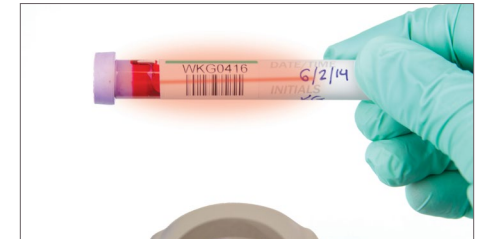
- 5. PEEL** the liner from the shield.
COVER the copy of the handwritten patient information with the shield.
SEAL the edges down using your fingers.



- 6. LABEL** any forms at the patient's bedside as required by your protocol.
REMOVE the tail of stickers from the band at the perforation.
ATTACH the tail of stickers to the specimen tube, if desired.



- 7. PEEL** the adhesive tab on the underside of extra stickers.
SECURE the extra stickers to the band.



- 8. TRANSPORT** the specimen to the blood bank.
SCAN the BBID into the LIS or enter it manually.
