The Barcode Plus™ | Handwritten Blood Band can be used with a pre-printed patient label. This solution allows you to save time and maximize efficiency, but also gives your facility the ability to handwrite information on the blood band as a backup method.



1. OBTAIN pre-printed patient labels per your protocol.

VERIFY the patient's identity.





 PLACE a patient label onto the area where there are prompts for handwriting. DO NOT REMOVE this handwriting label before applying the pre-printed label.

PEEL the liner from the shield and cover the patient label with the shield.

SEAL the edges down on a flat surface using your fingers.



3. WRAP the band tail around patient extremity to size.

SNAP the button closure to secure.

CUT the excess band tail material with scissors.



4. DRAW the pre-transfusion specimen per your protocol.

PEEL a specimen tube sticker from the band's tail and place it on the specimen tube lengthwise.

APPLY a pre-printed patient label onto the specimen tube.

SIGN/DATE as required by your protocol.



LABEL any forms at the patient's bedside as required by your protocol.

REMOVE the tail of stickers from the band at the perforation.



ATTACH the tail of stickers to the specimen tube, if desired.



 PEEL the adhesive tab on underside of extra stickers and secure to the band.

REMOVE the extra stickers with scissors if not required per your protocol.



8. TRANSPORT to the blood bank.

SCAN the Blood Bank ID (BBID) into the Laboratory Information System (LIS) or enter it manually.
