The first blood band designed specifically for transfusion patients, the Original Blood Band provides a unique Blood Bank ID (BBID) identifier in an easy to read alphanumeric format.



VERIFY the patient's identity.

WRITE the patient's information over the prompts on the band using a ballpoint pen.

NOTE: Press firmly while writing, as a copy of the handwritten information will remain on the band and darken over time.



WRAP the tail of detachable BBID stickers around the patient's extremity to size and align between the two plastic posts in the clip.

> **SECURE** the band by closing the self-cutting clip and pressing firmly.



3. DRAW the pre-transfusion specimen per your protocol.

PEEL the handwritten patient information label from band.



PLACE the handwritten patient information label on the specimen tube lengthwise.



LABEL any forms at the patient's bedside as required by your protocol.

> **REMOVE** the tail of detachable BBID stickers by holding the self-cutting clip and tearing away.



ATTACH the tail of stickers to the specimen tube, if desired.

> **TRANSPORT** the specimen to the blood bank.

ENTER the BBID into the Laboratory Information System (LIS).
