All foam core used is 5mm


All measurements are in millimeters





BOTTOM LAYER

Player Pieces, Player Aides, Power Tokens




BASE:	(9) 100x70
OUTSIDE LONG WALL:	(18) 100x27
OUTSIDE SHORT WALL:	(17) 60x27
POWER TOKEN LIFTS:	(2) 60X16

NOTES:

- I had to cut out the back wall of the power token storage box by about 2.5mm to get the player aides to fit. This could be fixed by making a row of these a bit shorter but the cut out worked fine.

MIDDLE LAYER

100 point, Action, Scoring, Game end tokens



NOTES:

- I used the large 180x300 piece to boost up the player boards for potential expansion boards.


SPACER:	(1) 180X300
BASE:	(1) 300x30
LONG WALL:	(1) 185x15
SHORT WALLS:	(3) 25x15

TOP LAYER

Terrain, Coins, Cities, Bonuses, Blessings

COINS

BASE: (1) 170x80
OUTSIDE LONG WALL: (2) 170x15
OUTSIDE SHORT WALL: (2) 70x15
INTERIOR WALLS: (2) 70x15



TERRAIN TILES

BASE: (1) 300x40
OUTSIDE LONG WALL: (1) 300x15
OUTSIDE SHORT WALL: (2) 35x15
INTERIOR WALLS: (6) 35x15

BONUS TILES

BASE: (1) 220x170
CUTOUT: (1) 220x170

BLESSINGS

BASE: (1) 220x123
CUTOUT (1) 220x123

CITIES

BASE: (1) 220x47
CUTOUT (1) 220x47

NOTES:

- For all cutouts use the game pieces and use a pencil to outline their layout. Use those outlines as a guide to cut the inset cutouts.
