

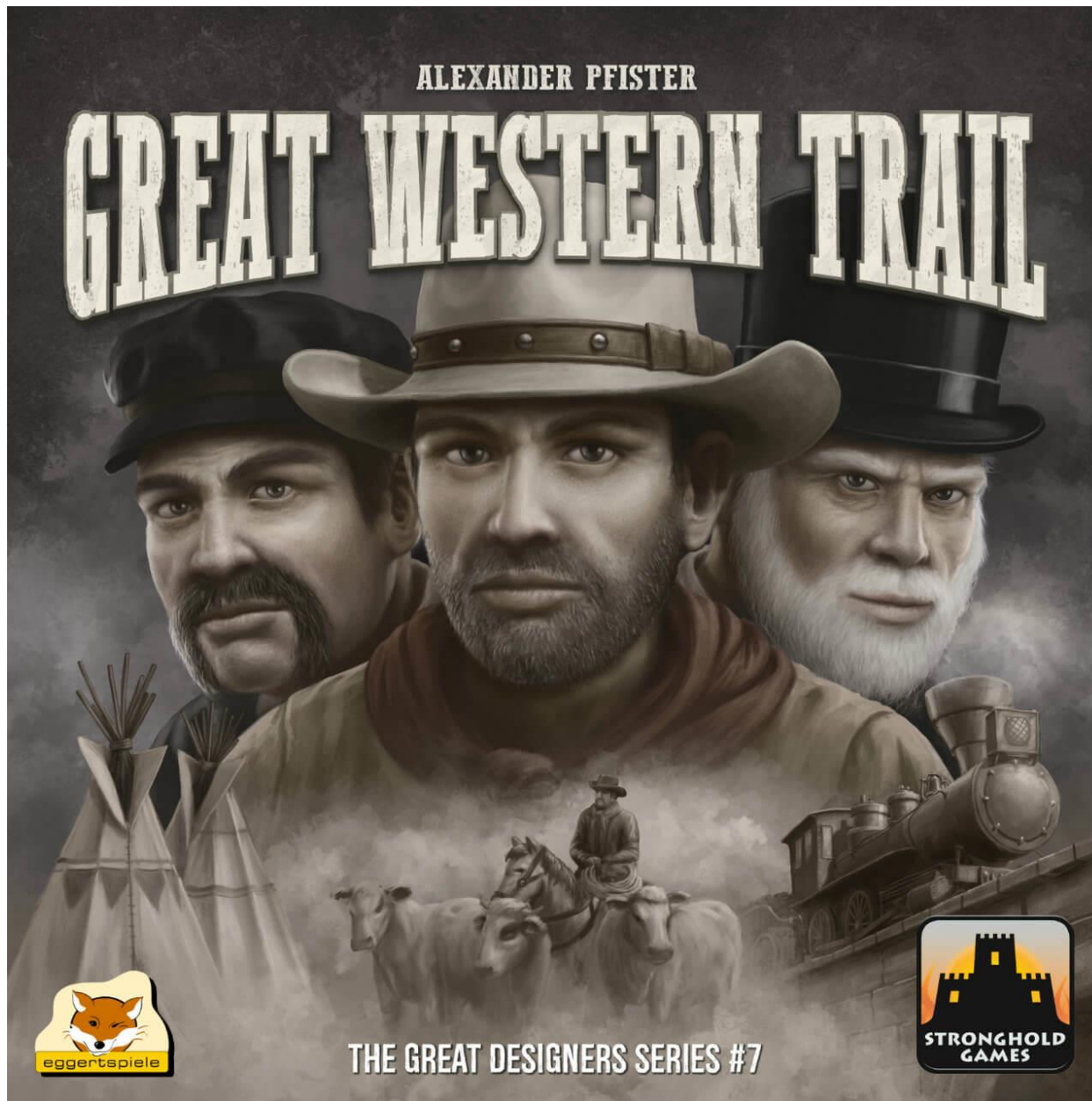

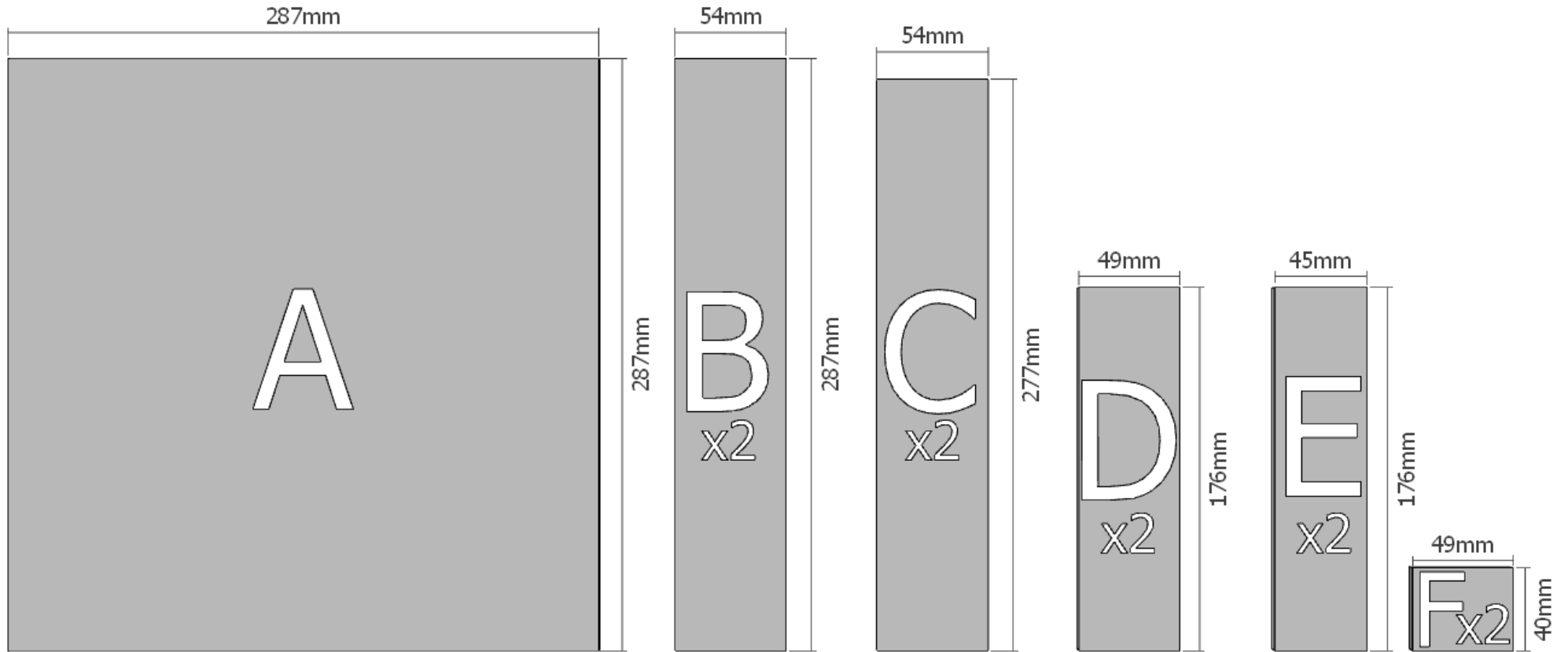
All foam core used is 5mm

All measurements are in millimeters

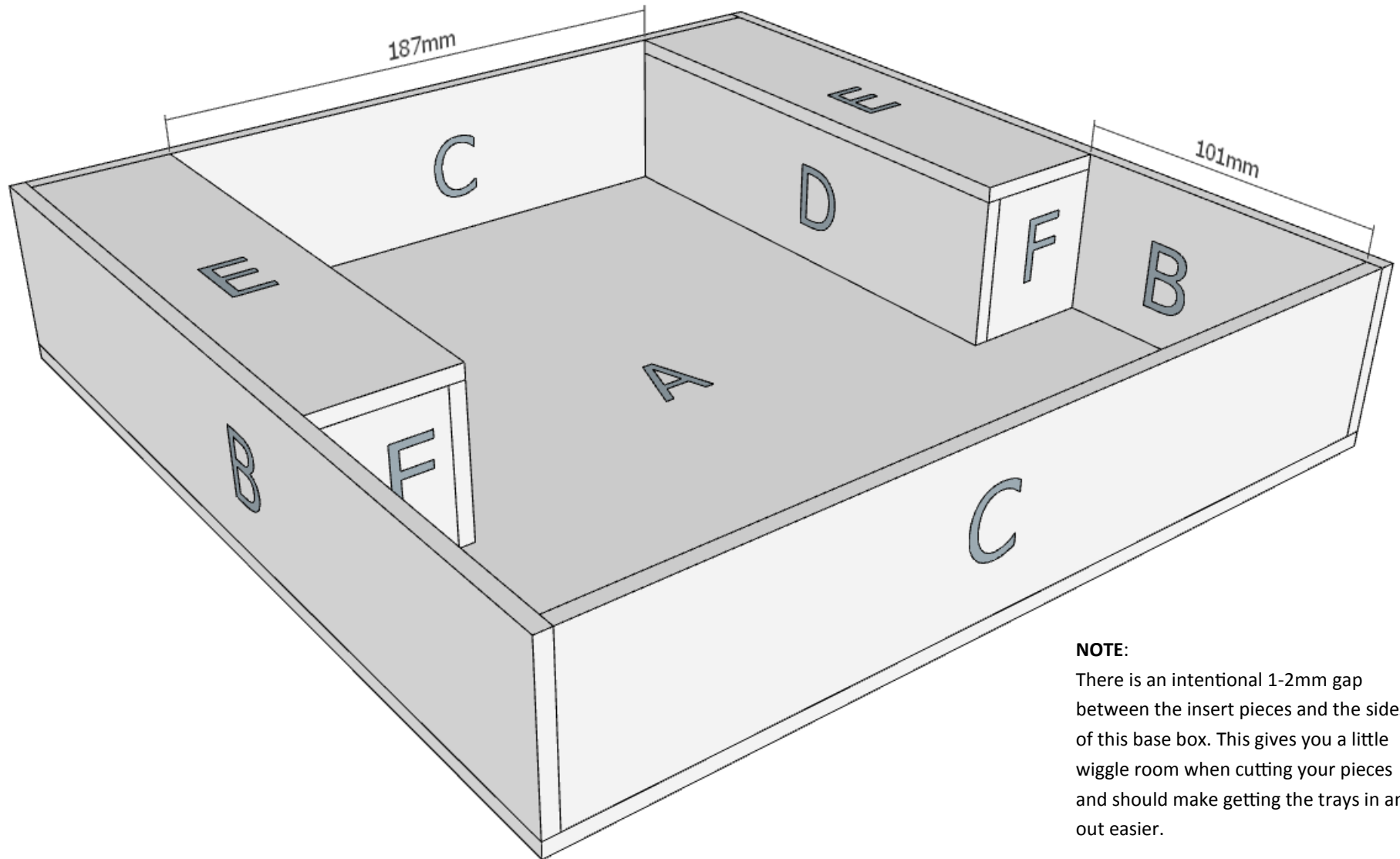
There is no storage tray for the Kansas City Supply tiles – they are stored in draw bags in the middle of the insert.

BASE BOX - CONSTRUCTION



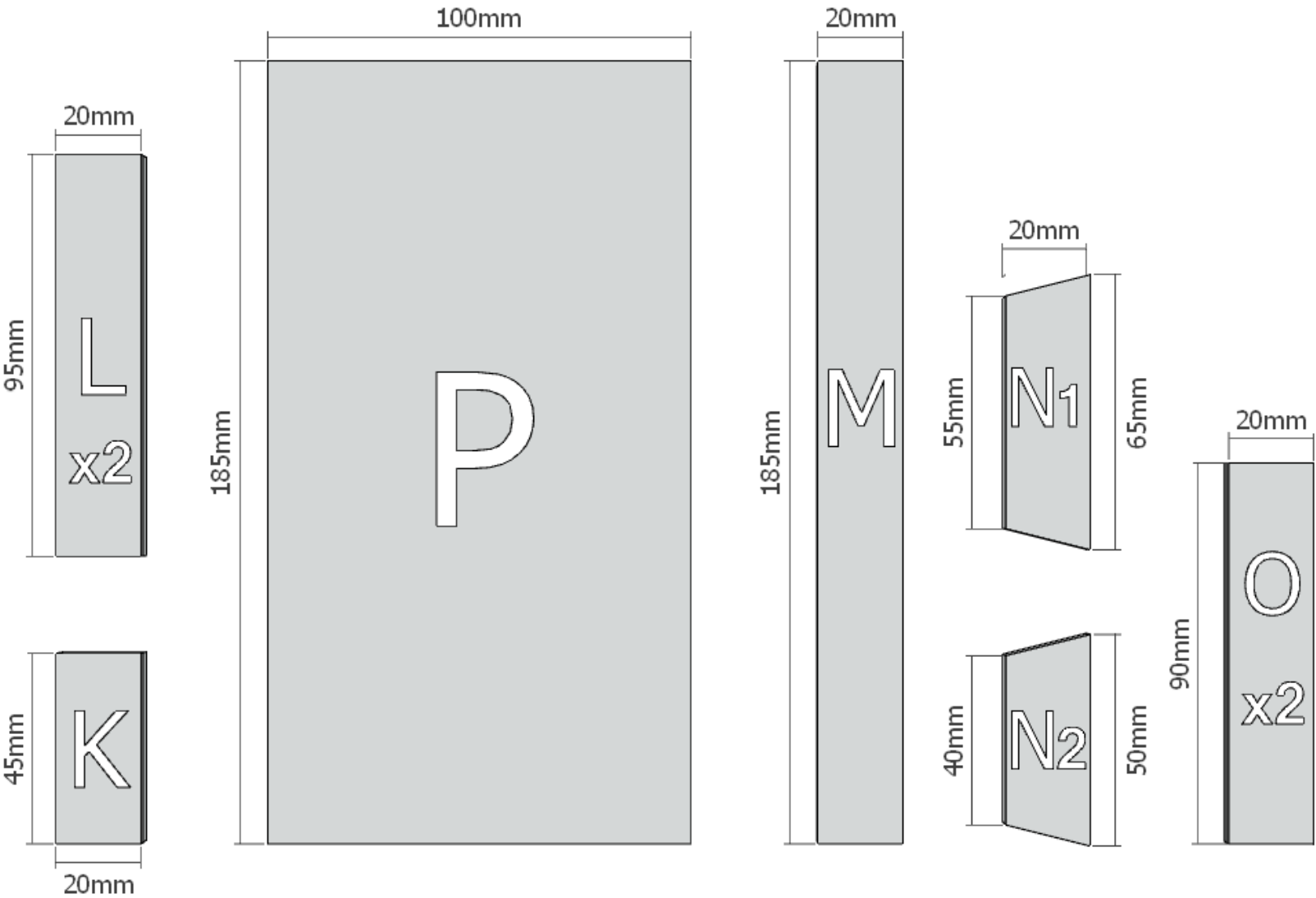
NOTE:

There is an intentional 1-2mm gap between the insert pieces and the sides of this base box. This gives you a little wiggle room when cutting your pieces and should make getting the trays in and out easier.



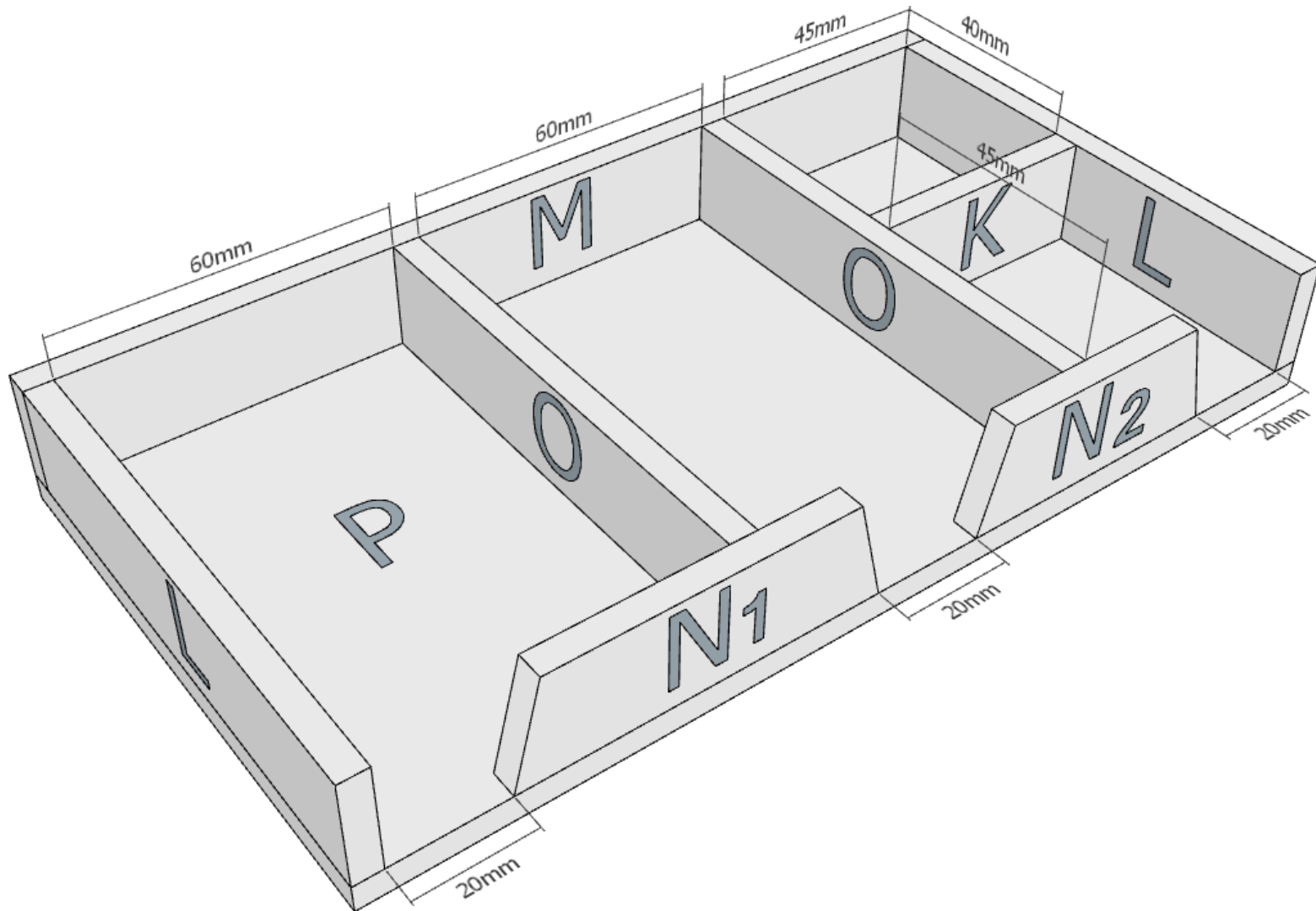

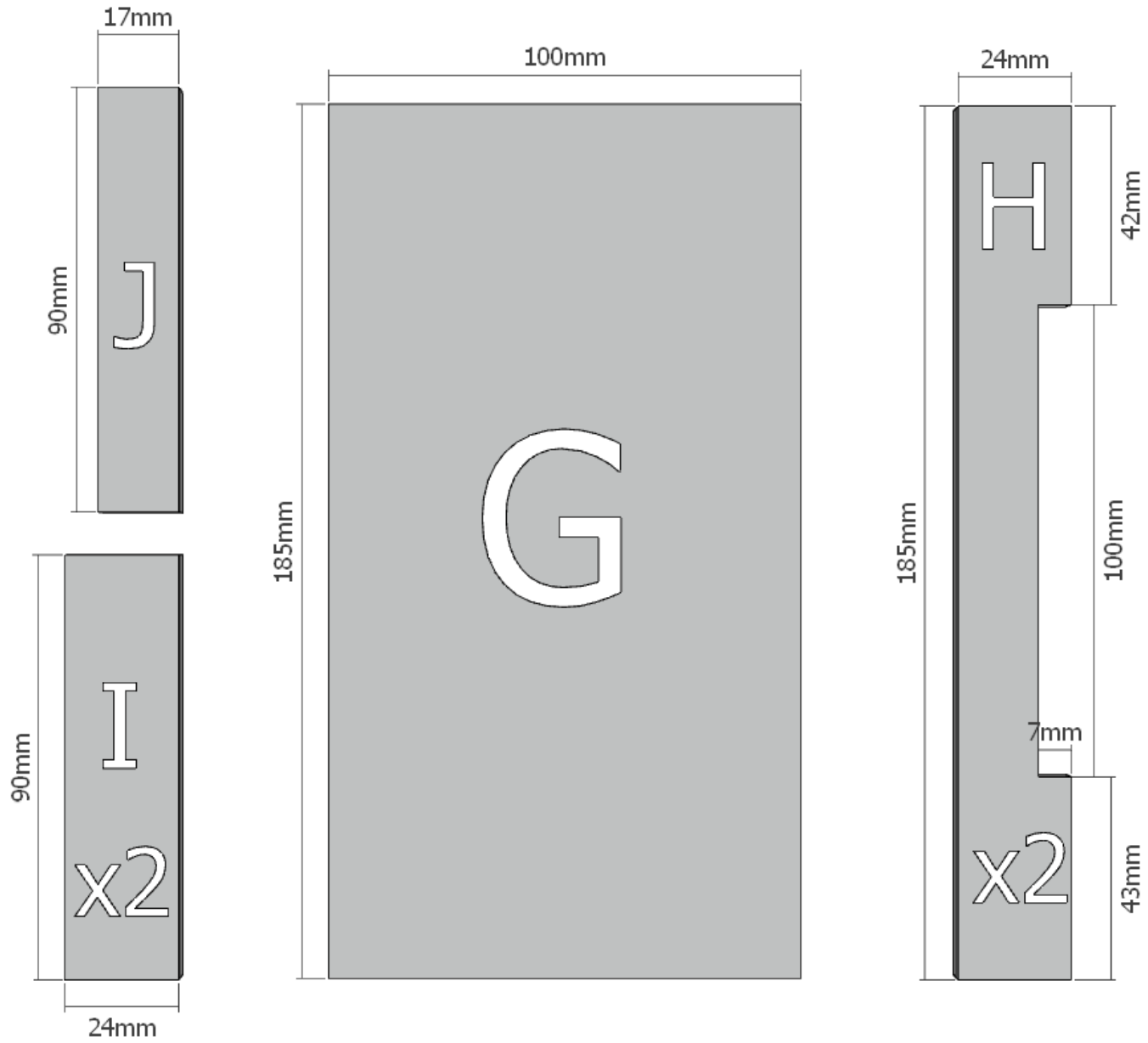
CARDS & NEUTRAL BUILDINGS - CONSTRUCTION

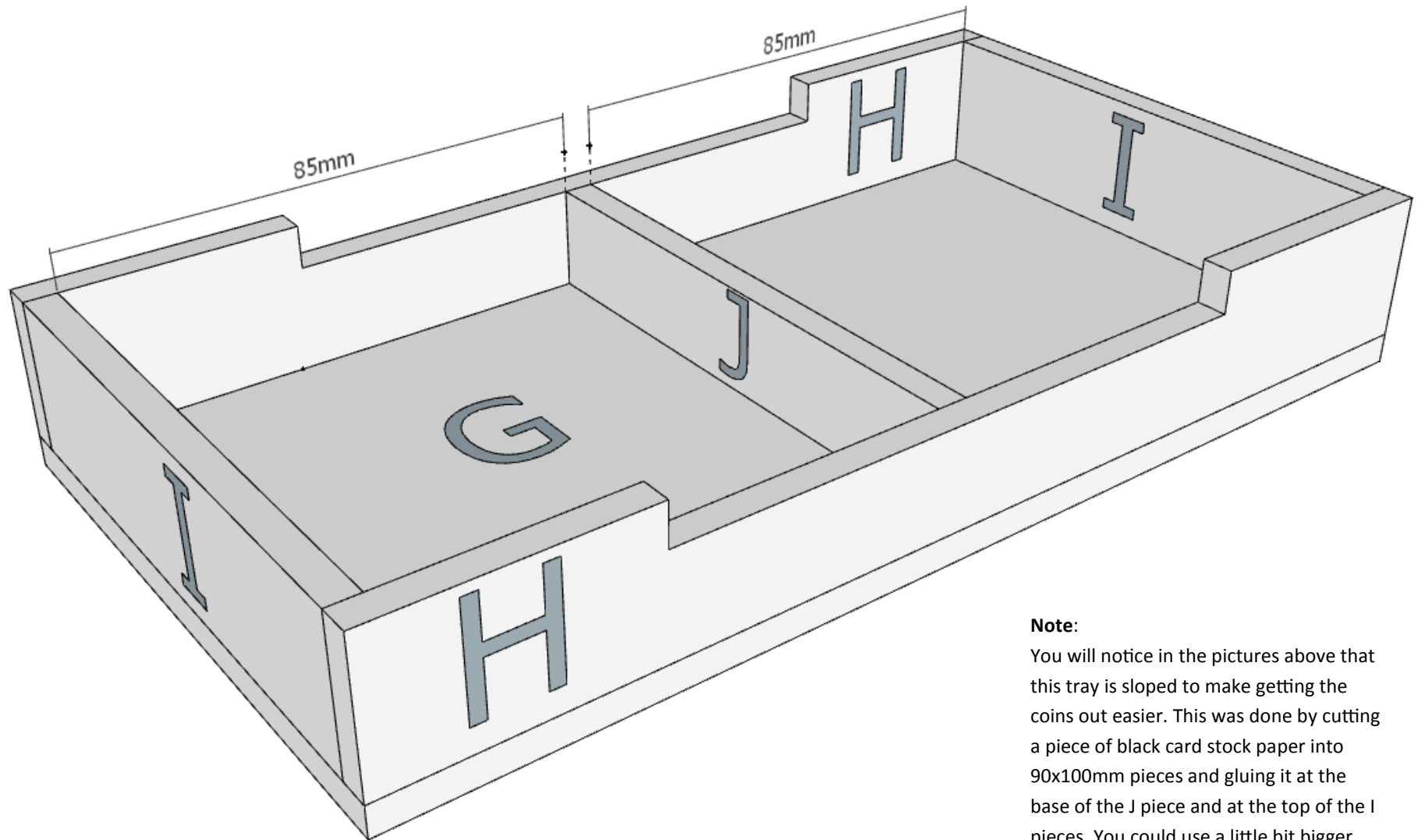
MONEY TRAY - CUTS

Coins, Scoring Pad



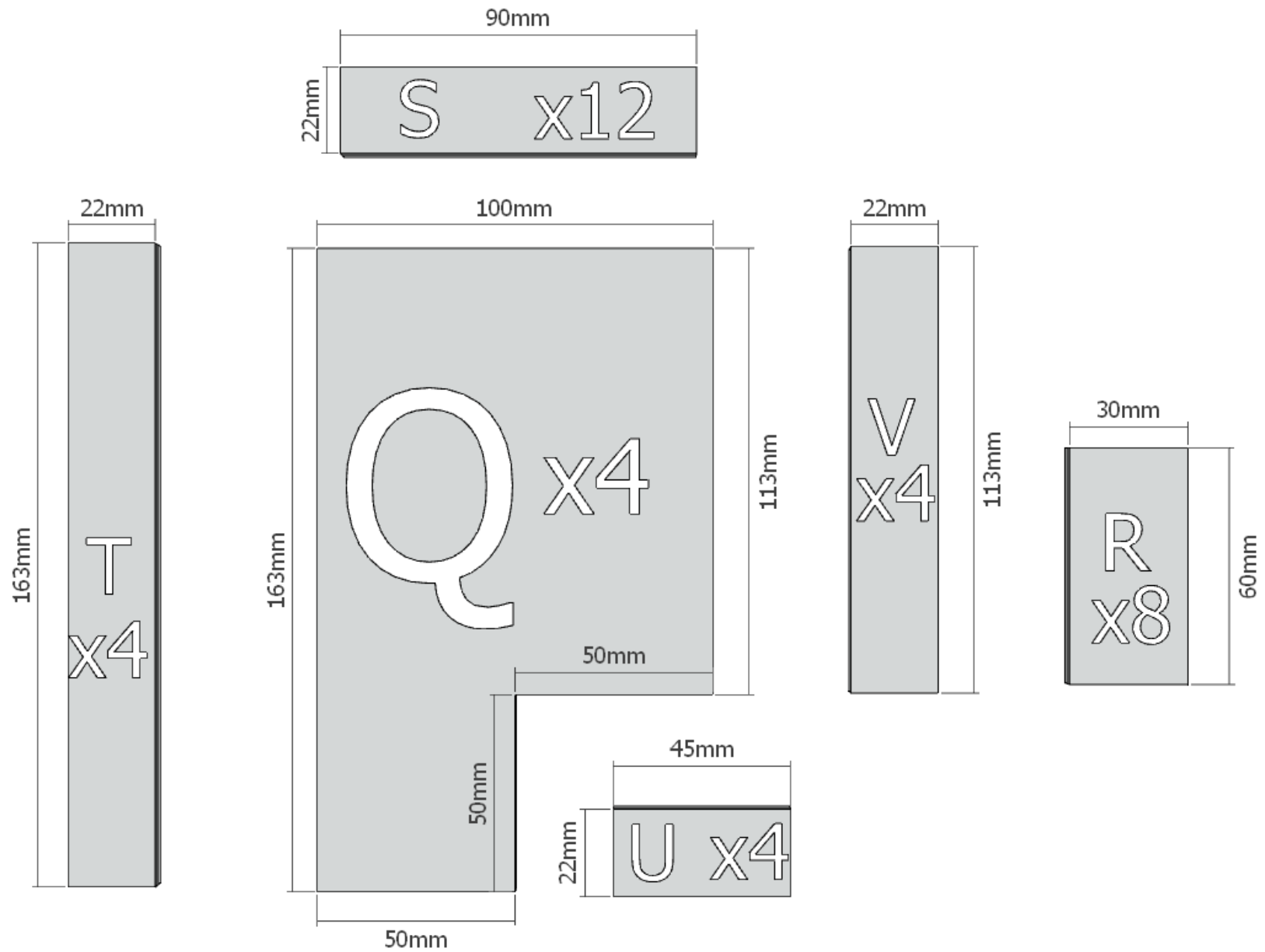
Note:

You will notice in the pictures above that this tray is sloped to make getting the coins out easier. This was done by cutting a piece of black card stock paper into 90x100mm pieces and gluing it at the base of the J piece and at the top of the I pieces. You could use a little bit bigger piece to get a gentler slope than I did.



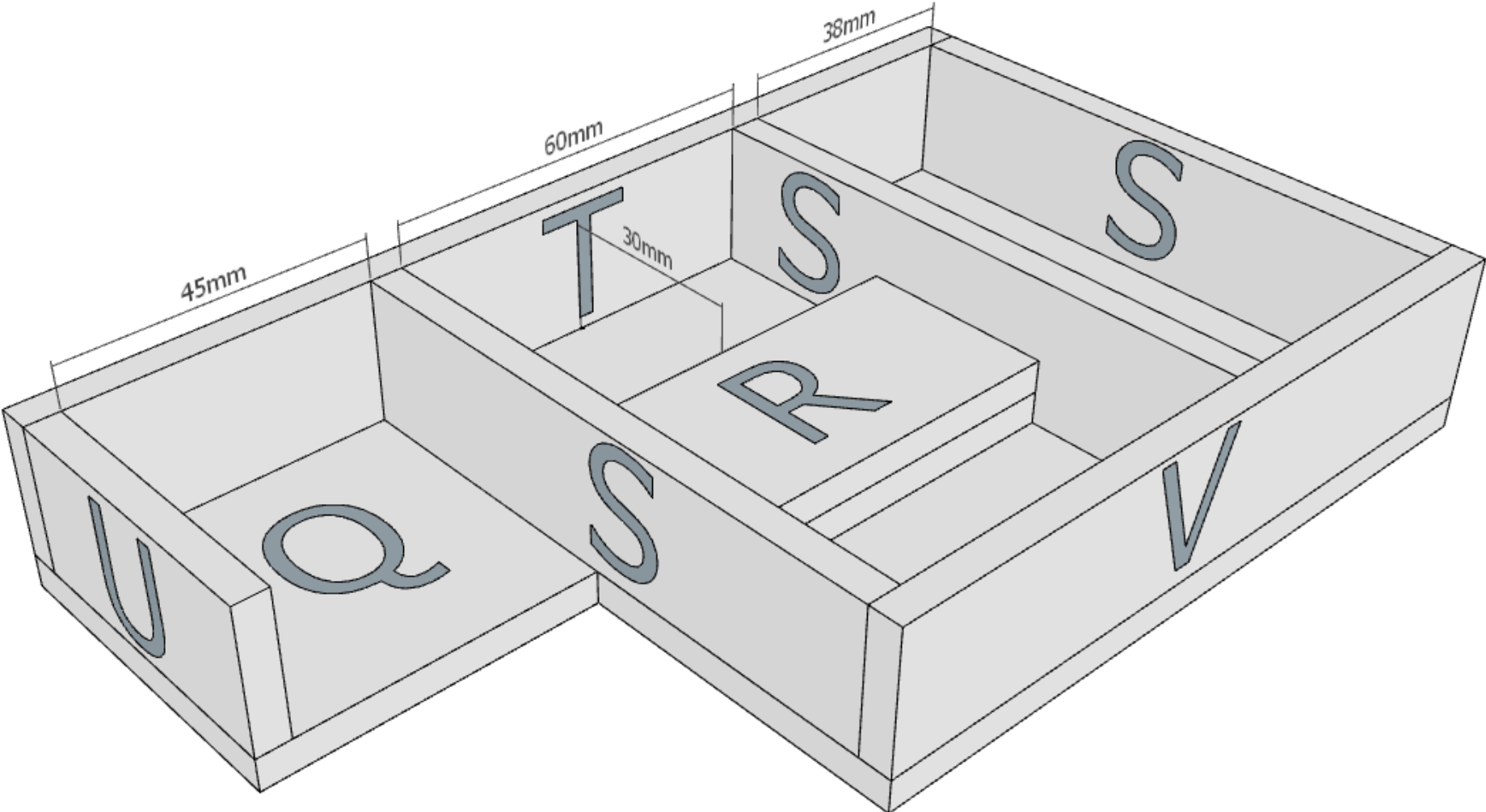

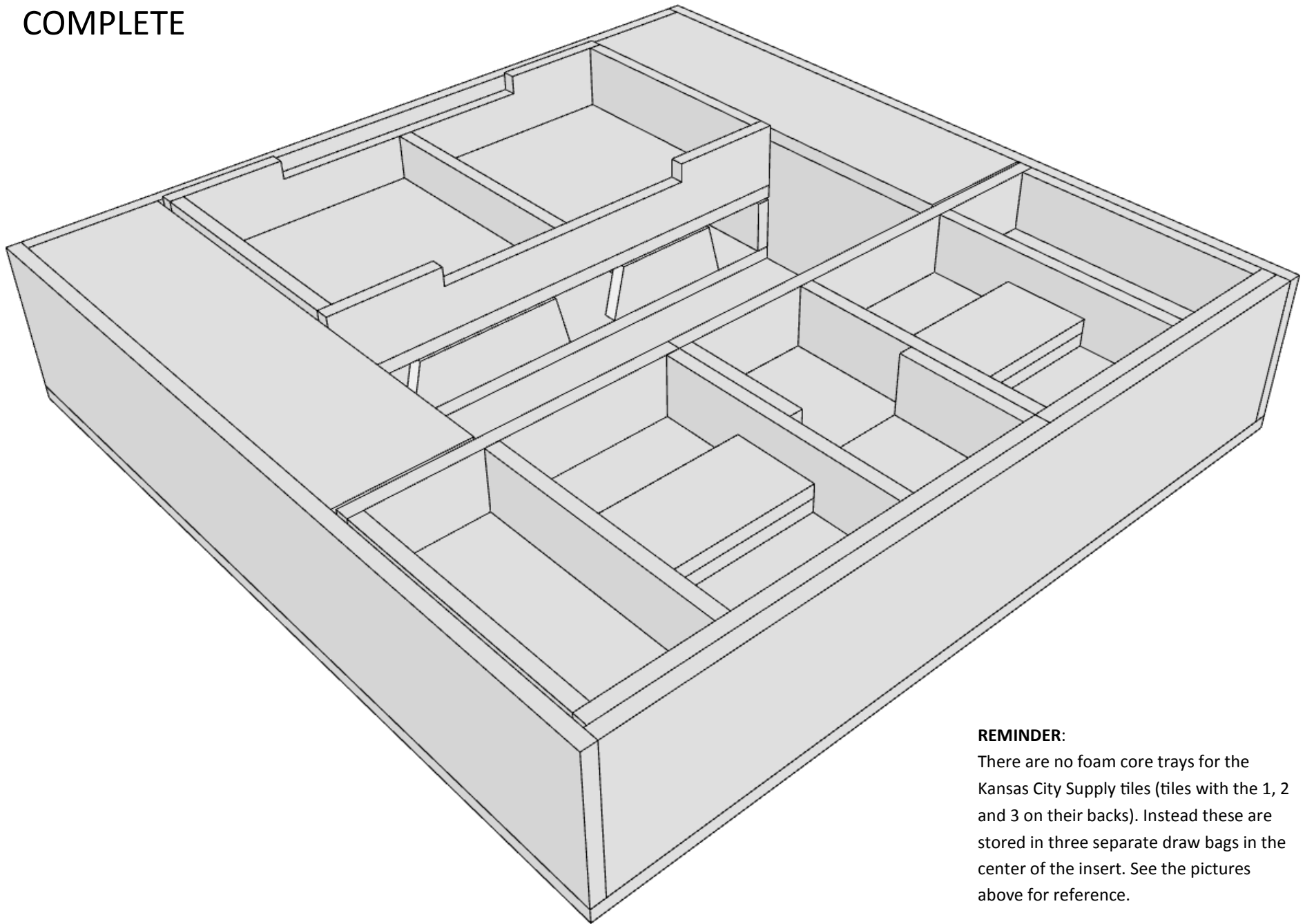


PLAYER TRAY - CONSTRUCTION
