

- Please arrive on time, and if doing your own hair and makeup, arrive makeup and hair ready. This will maximize your time in front of the camera.

You can relax, have a drink, and enjoy some light snacks while we discuss the shoot. *Please note, if you have booked a mini shoot, we will be scheduling several sessions in one day and will likely be in with another client when you arrive. 


