July 2

July 3

Arrival in Johannesburg, South Africa. We will arrange for VIP meet and greet service at Johannesburg Airport. You will then be whisked through customs to your connecting flight to Victoria Falls.

July 3-6

We will spend our first 3 nights at Old Drift Lodge in Zimbabwe. Here we will tour the majestic Victoria Falls (one of the 7 wonders of the world) and visit an elephant orphanage and sanctuary where you will be able to have your picture taken with the elephants! Back at Old Drift Lodge, we will enjoy the beautiful scenery, river safaris, and game drives.

July 6-9

On the morning of July 6th, our guide will meet us and we will be transported by plane to Phinda Mountain Lodge in South Africa. The Phinda Private Game Reserve is especially unique because of its massive territory and the presences of 7 different ecosystems. In cooperation, these two features will provide plenty of opportunities for Big Five (lion, leopard, buffalo, elephant, & rhino), cheetah, and extremely rare antelope viewing, among other animals. Phinda is home to one of the largest populations of black rhino, and tracking opportunities will be available here. For an additional fee, the lodge also provides experiences such as turtle viewing and scuba diving at the nearby coastline.

July 9-12

Following three nights at Phinda, we will journey to our third and final lodge, the Ngala Safari Lodge, where we will round out our trip for three more nights. Ngala Safari Lodge is situated in the Ngala Private Game Reserve, which shares an unfenced boundary with the world-renowned Kruger National Park, South Africa's largest wildlife sanctuary and one of the biggest game reserves in the world. A spectacular diversity of wildlife moves through this immense wilderness, including breeding herds of elephant, leopard, spotted hyena, giraffe, large buffalo herds and white rhino. Needless to say, our safari experiences here will be nothing short of thrilling!

July 12th

The end of our magical time together has come and it's time for us to return home or depart for additional travel. For those going directly home, you can expect to arrive in Texas midday on the 13th.



expect on Safari


Game drives--which may take place in the morning, afternoon, or evening-involve going out in a specialized 4x4 vehicle with a driver guide who is an expert in tracking the local wildlife. From the safety of the vehicle, you will have the opportunity to get an up close look at these incredible creatures in their natural habitat. You can expect to see everything from a cheetah stalking its prey to a lioness cuddling her cubs to a herd of elephants splashing in the river. The animals will be going about their daily lives as if you aren't there, and that's what makes observing them so fascinating.




Bush walks are guided and designed to allow you to experience Africa in a more immersive way than you do in a vehicle. On foot, you can walk through game tracks, smell the flora and fauna, and happen upon wildlife and birds that would scare away from a vehicle (don't worry--your guide will be armed!). As one guide put it, "From a vehicle, you see Africa. On foot, you feel, hear and smell Africa."



River safaris add a stunning layer to any safari experience. Aside from a relaxing way to take in the beautiful scenery, game viewing can be most remarkable from the water. A river safari provides an entirely different and remarkably close angle to experience the wildlife. Elephant line the water's edge, hippo congregate in lagoons, hundreds of antelope and giraffe make their way to the water and sightings of predators along the river banks are common.








Accomposations

Let me address what you're really curious about: we WILL have airconditioning, electricity, and hot water!!





Good to know: all of your food and beverages are included! Yes, that means alcohol.




