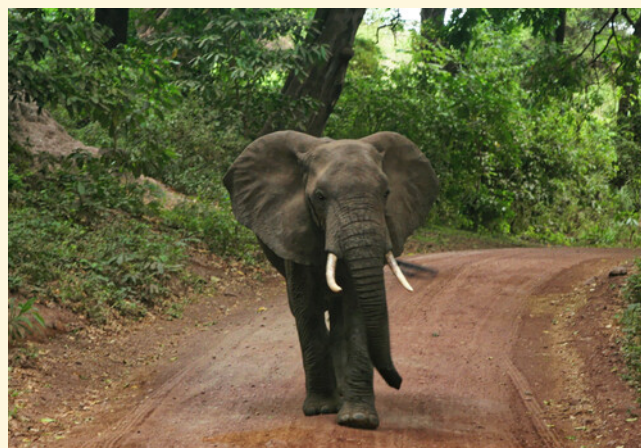
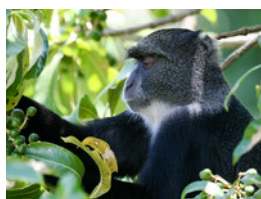
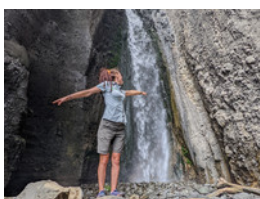
Arusha National Park

It's time to begin your safari. Welcome to Tanzania! We will pick you at Kilimanjaro Airport at your arrival (or in your hotel in Arusha or Moshi, if you've arrived a day before), and drive you to Arusha National Park.

You'll hardly find any more beautiful corner of the Rift Valley than Arusha National Park. You'll see wildlife – giraffe, zebra and buffalo, wonderfully varied birdlife. The scenery here is also to impress, from the near-perfect volcanic cone that crowns the summit of Mt Meru to the Ngurdoto Crater, which often goes by the name of 'Little Ngorongoro'. Your visit to Arusha National Park is a perfect, relaxed opening to your Northern Circuit safari adventure.

- Transfer to **Raha Wildlife Resort** (around 30 mins)

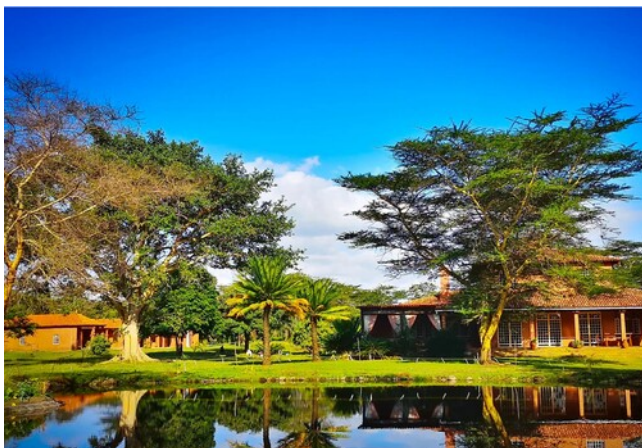

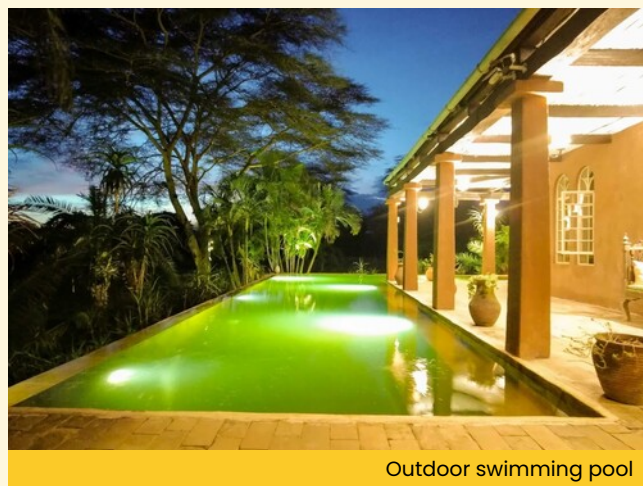

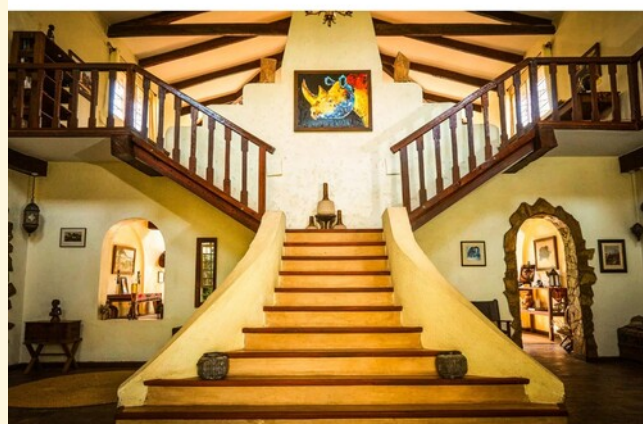

Lake Natron

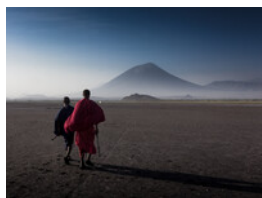

Another highlight of your visit here will be the views you can enjoy of the stunning volcano, Ol Doinyo Lengai, which rises above the lake's southern shore.

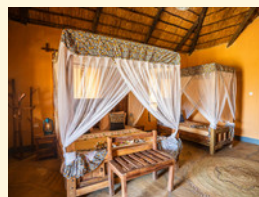

The landscape in Africa Safari Lake Natron is of unprecedented raw beauty; a dramatic lava desert with a high alkaline lake in a depression created by the Rift Valley. The swimming pool offers a beautiful view of Ol Doinyo Lengai. Northern Serengeti. Great Migration

Of all areas in the Serengeti National Park, the Northern Serengeti could just be the most special. Whenever you're here, you can expect fantastic wildlife (big cats, elephants and migrating wildebeest herds) and much quieter safari trails, especially when compared to the rest of the park. The landscape is also unique, with rolling grasslands, hills and the iconic Mara River.

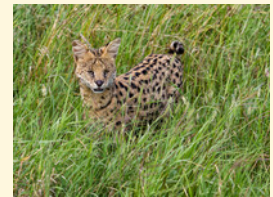

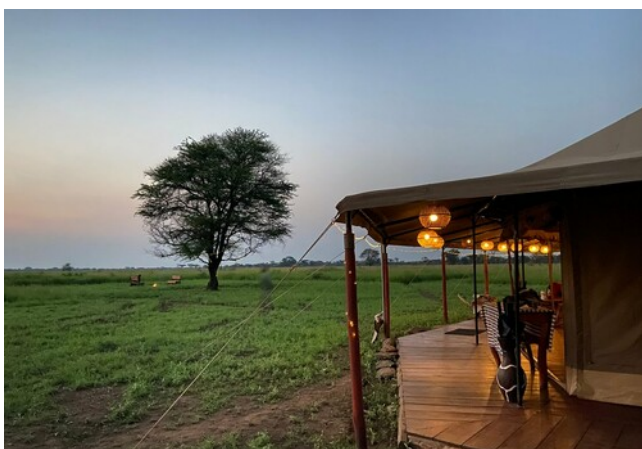

From Serengeti to Ngorongoro Crater rim

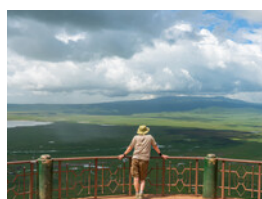
Your safari day begins early in the Serengeti with a game drive across the vast plains alive with wildlife — lions, elephants, giraffes, hippos, crocodiles and more. After a picnic lunch in the bush, you continue driving southeast through stunning landscapes, passing Maasai villages and spotting more animals along the way. Later in the afternoon, you enter the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, ascending the crater highlands with sweeping views over the plains. The day ends at your campsite on the crater rim, where you can enjoy a sunset over the Ngorongoro Crater.

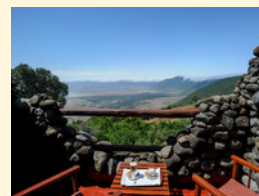
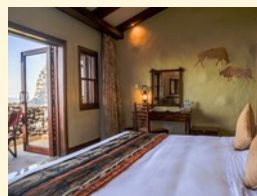

Today you'll visit Ngorongoro Crater, one of the most beautiful natural sights in Africa, a place where you'll experience otherworldly beauty with extraordinary wildlife. Watch as, from above, morning mist rolls up and over the crater rim, and notice how the steep walls suggest a place unlike any other. Down below on the crater floor, explore a lost world preserved in a state of pristine isolation, one that shelters lions and hyenas, elephants and black rhinos, flamingos and golden jackals. There are also forests, hippo-filled lakes, a salt pan and hyena dens, and you'll never lose the sense that you've stumbled into a safari theme park where everything's wild.

Tarangire National Park

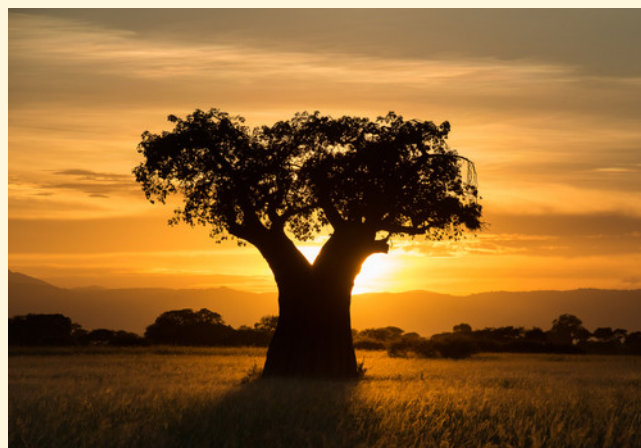
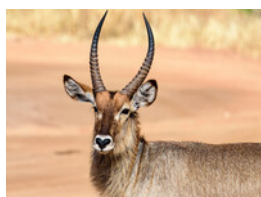
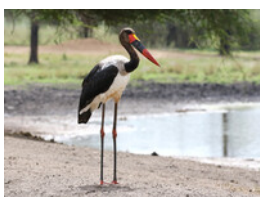
Tarangire is famous for towering baobab trees and large herds of elephants. You'll likely spot lions, while cheetahs and leopards roam nearby. Expect to see wildebeest, giraffes, hippos, buffalo, and zebras against a stunning backdrop of riverine woodlands, open plains, and rolling hills — with perfect vantage points to take it all in. Tarangire is also a birdwatcher's paradise, home to over 500 species, from vibrant lilac-breasted rollers to elegant fish eagles along the riverbanks. After your final game drive, we'll take you wherever you need to go next. This marks the end of your Great Migration & Big 5 safari. We hope you've seen them all! If you have a longer holiday, we also invite you to continue your journey – perhaps exploring the foothills of Mt Kilimanjaro, or unwinding on Zanzibar's beautiful beaches.
