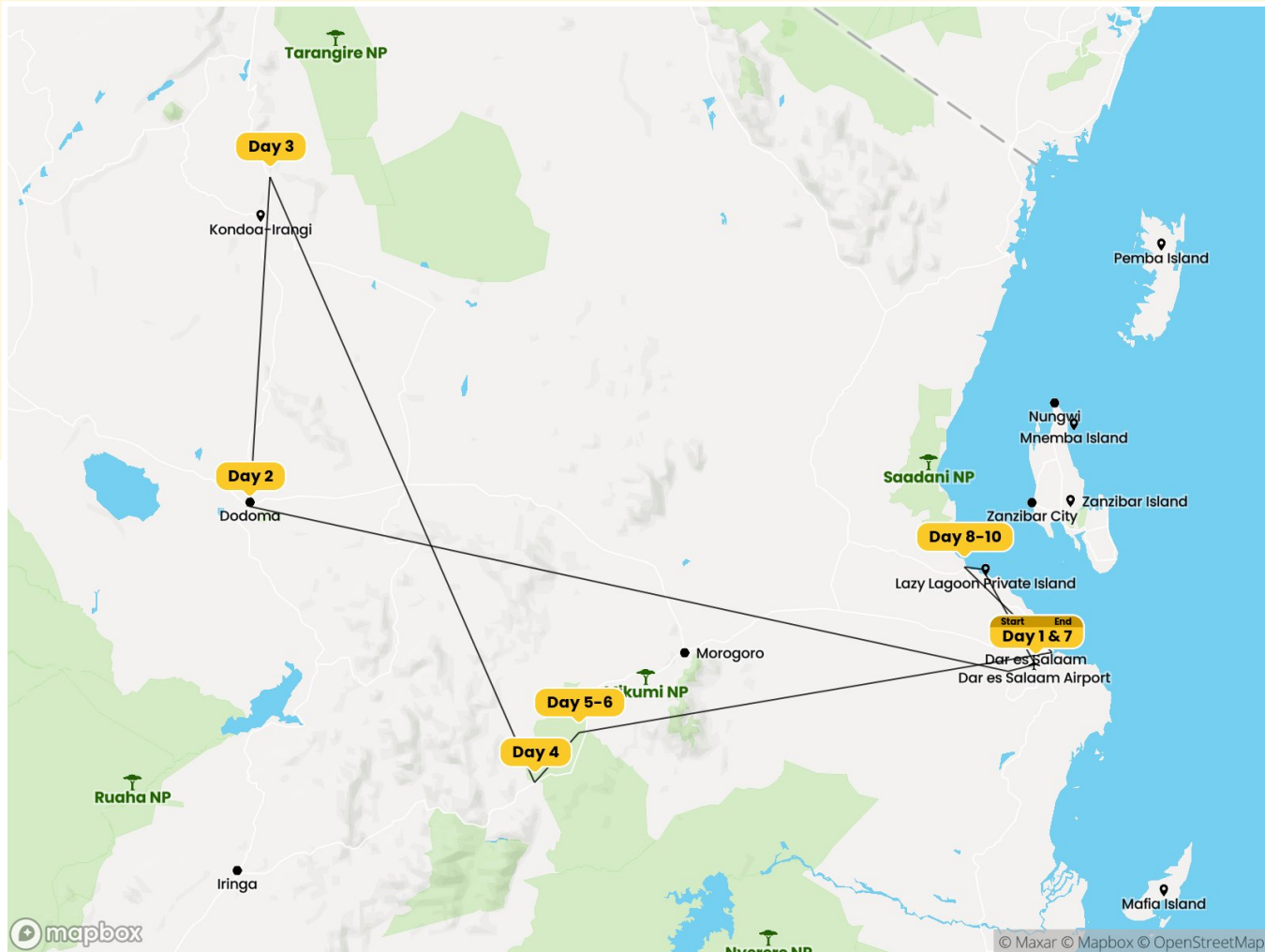

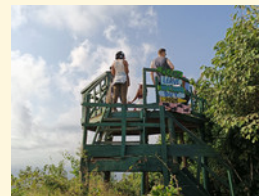

Remarkably, Tanzania ranks as the second-largest grape-winer producer in Sub-Saharan Africa, just behind South Africa. You'll end the day with an exquisite, curated wine-tasting experience in at a charming wine estate.

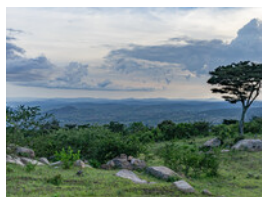
This hidden gem is one of the most off-the-beaten-track destinations in the country. Tanzania is the cradle of mankind and you will see the earliest signs with your own eyes.

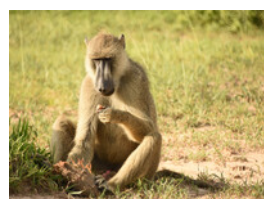

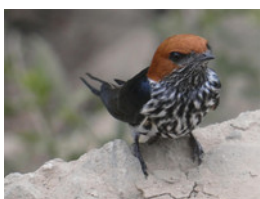

Stanley's Kopje

Tented camp

Stanley's Kopje is the only camp in Mikumi National Park built on a rocky hill overlooking the Mkata floodplain and the prime game-viewing area at Mwanamboga waterhole. The camp sits high with full 360° views of the wilderness, while its 12 tented rooms are set around the lower slopes, each on raised wooden platforms with thatched roofs and a private veranda looking out over the plains and passing wildlife.

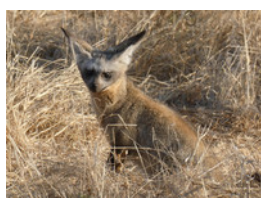

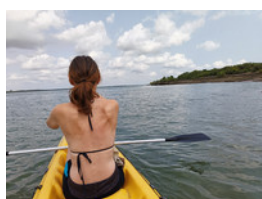
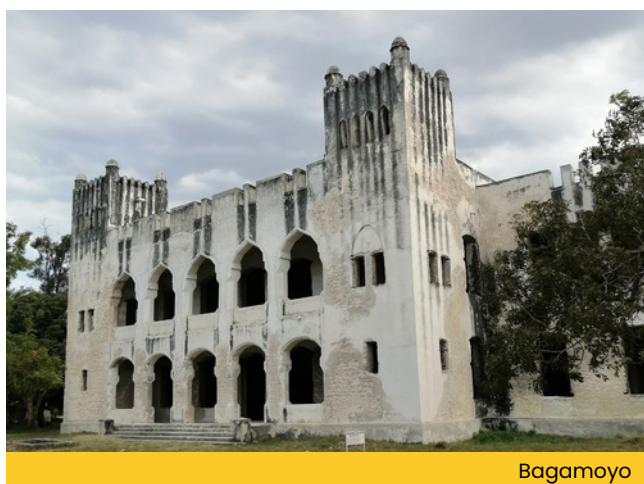

Begin the part of your journey on the Swahili coast with a historical tour of Bagamoyo. Explore the old slave trade market, the Catholic Mission Church, and the ancient Kaole Ruins, while discovering the town's rich heritage and vibrant local culture.

As icing on the cake, unwind at Lazy Lagoon Private Island, a secluded tropical paradise with soft white sands and crystal-clear waters. Relax on the beach or near swimming pool, enjoy watersports such as kayaking, snorkeling, and paddleboarding. Sail on a traditional dhow boat to a disappearing sandbank that emerges only at low tide, where pristine sands and turquoise waters create a fleeting, magical island experience.

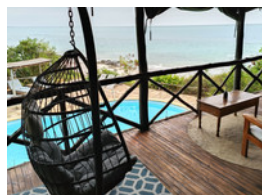

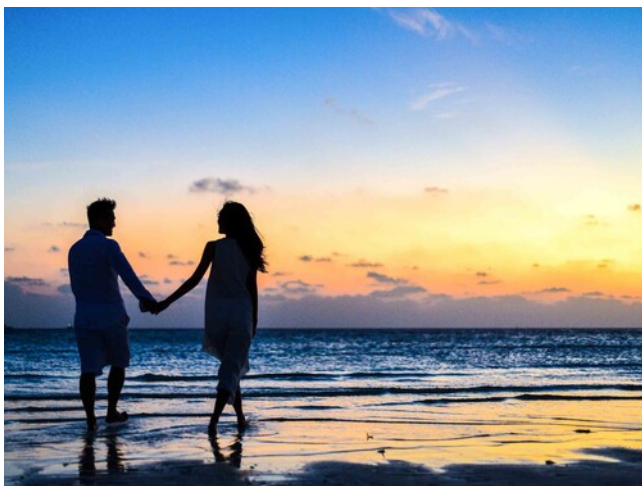

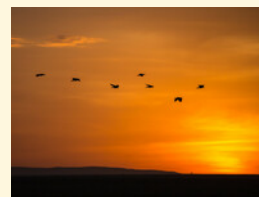
