

Kigoma City. Lake Tanganyika

Forget the well-trodden safari paths. Fly 2.5 hours from Dar es Salaam to Kigoma - welcome to Western Tanzania! Upon arrival, your driver will transfer you to a serene resort on the shores of Lake Tanganyika.

Few travelers venture this far, offering a glimpse of Tanzania beyond the tourist trail. Explore colorful markets, colonial-era architecture, and nearby fishing villages that bring Kigoma's charm to life. This laidback port city, founded on the eastern shores of Lake Tanganyika, once served as the terminus for colonial railways and the site where explorer Dr. David Livingstone was found in nearby Ujiji.

Lake Tanganyika itself is the region's crown jewel - one of the world's oldest and longest freshwater lakes, second only by depth and volume. Its crystal-clear waters and unique fish species make it a remarkable natural wonder and a peaceful, off-the-beaten-path destination.



Day 3 & 4

Gombe National Park

Begin your day with a scenic 2-hour motorboat ride from Kigoma across the sparkling waters of Lake Tanganyika to Gombe Stream National Park, where you'll spend the next two nights immersed in the land of wild chimpanzees and pristine rainforest beauty.

Break down the barriers between you and our closest animal relatives in Gombe. Beginning in the 1960s, Jane Goodall and her team have been studying the chimps. As a result, these engaging primates, although still wild, have grown accustomed to spending their time with people. Head out into the forest to look for them and visit the original feeding station where Goodall began her work all those years ago.

There's something special about spending time with the chimps in the place where the legendary conservationist made them famous. You won't find a more rewarding safari experience than sharing quality time with these soulful creatures.

And don't forget the olive baboons, which have been intensively studied and are just as easy to get close to. Out in the forest, watch for other primates: red-tailed monkeys, blue monkeys, vervet monkeys and red colobus.




Accommodation | Day 3 & 4 Kasekela Tented Camp
