Tarangire National Park

This morning we'll pick you up from Kilimanjaro Airport, or from your location in Arusha or Moshi. Your adventurous safari starts right away!

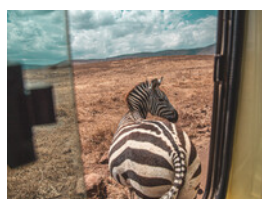
Tarangire is famous for towering baobab trees and large herds of elephants. You'll likely spot lions, while cheetahs and leopards roam nearby. Expect to see wildebeest, giraffes, hippos, buffalo, and zebras against a stunning backdrop of riverine woodlands, open plains, and rolling hills — with perfect vantage points to take it all in. Tarangire is also a birdwatcher's paradise, home to over 500 species, from vibrant lilac-breasted rollers to elegant fish eagles along the riverbanks.

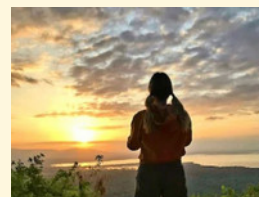


Game drive in Tarangire National Park



Accommodation | Day 1
Panorama Campsite

Stay up high at Panorama Safari Camp on the edge of the Great Rift Valley, atop the escarpment that rises dramatically above Lake Manyara. The views are pretty special, while the camp is simple but has character and all the basics for a safari overnight. There's also a bar and restaurant area, where our safari chef will serve you dinner and breakfast. It's a convenient base for moving on towards Serengeti-Ngorongoro ecosystem.

Serengeti National Park

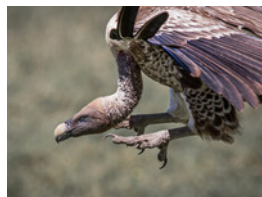
Discover just why so many safari visitors fall in love with the Serengeti. Keep an eye out for big cats, even bigger elephants, and almost every kind of safari wildlife you can imagine. You might also see giraffe, impala, zebra, wildebeest, buffalo, hundreds of species of birds, and that may all just be before breakfast. You'll never forget watching these animals interact, whether you see a hunt, a vast herd or a mother protecting her cub or calf. The Serengeti's scenery is also unforgettable – observe Africa's iconic acacia trees, the park's golden grasslands and great piles of boulders known as kopjes.

Day 3

From Serengeti to Ngorongoro Crater rim

Your safari day begins early in the Serengeti with a game drive across the vast plains alive with wildlife — lions, elephants, giraffes, hippos, crocodiles and more. After a picnic lunch in the bush, you continue driving southeast through stunning landscapes, passing Maasai villages and spotting more animals along the way. Later in the afternoon, you enter the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, ascending the crater highlands with sweeping views over the plains. The day ends at your campsite on the crater rim, where you can enjoy a sunset over the Ngorongoro Crater.

Ngorongoro Simba Campsite

Bush camp

Ngorongoro Simba Campsite occupies one of the best locations anywhere around the Ngorongoro Crater rim. It's a simple campsite with excellent crater views, and it's very well positioned for you to be among the first down into the crater at first light. It's also popular with travelers, which makes it a good place to swap safari stories.

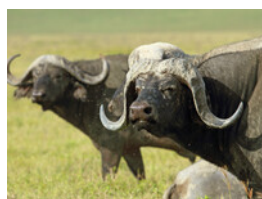

Day 4

Ngorongoro Crater

The magical Ngorongoro is a place unlike anywhere else in Africa. Cloud forests encircle the crater rim, and the view out across the caldera of this former volcano – quite apart from the altitude – will leave you gasping for air. Your drive down a steep trail carries you onto the crater floor where a unique wildlife offering is added to the sheer beauty of the experience. You'll share the sunken ecosystem of the crater floor with hyenas, lions, elephants, black rhinos and hippos. An ecosystem has developed in the crater over thousands of years since the volcano released its powerful eruption on the land. It could just be one of your best safari days ever.

Return for another night at Panorama Campsite, which offers dramatic views of Lake Manyara. It's a great base for exploring this magical national park tomorrow.

Day 5

Lake Manyara National Park

Almost everyone who visits Lake Manyara falls in love with this unique park. Lake Manyara is most famous for being one of the few parks in Africa where its lions climb trees. It's not unusual to look up into the branches of Lake Manyara's forest canopy and find yourself face-to-face with a lion (or even an entire pride). Large populations of elephants and olive baboons are further highlights, while the backdrop to all wildlife sightings here is the dramatic Rift Valley escarpment which rises over the park's western boundary, or pretty Lake Manyara itself which dominates the east.

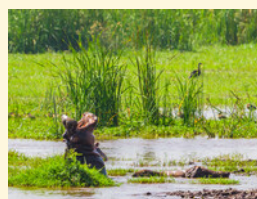
