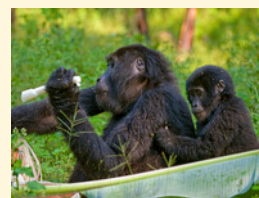
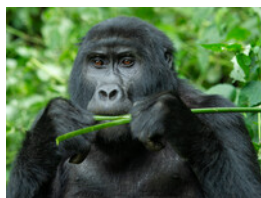
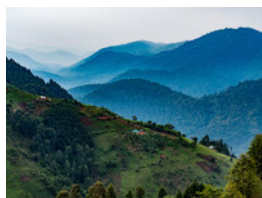
We suggest you to take a direct flight from Entebbe International Airport to Kisoro Airport, your gateway to the world of mountain gorillas.

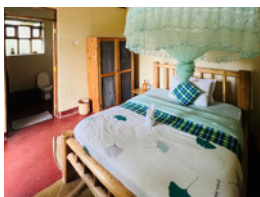

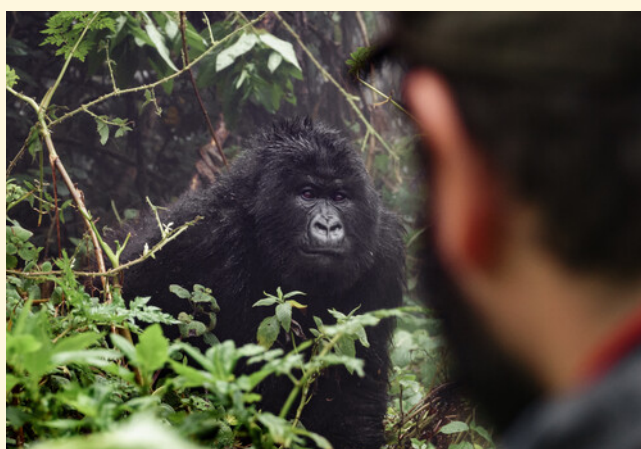

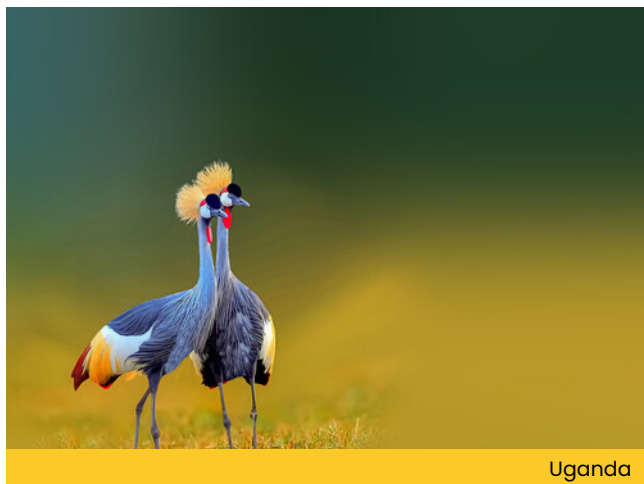
Day 3

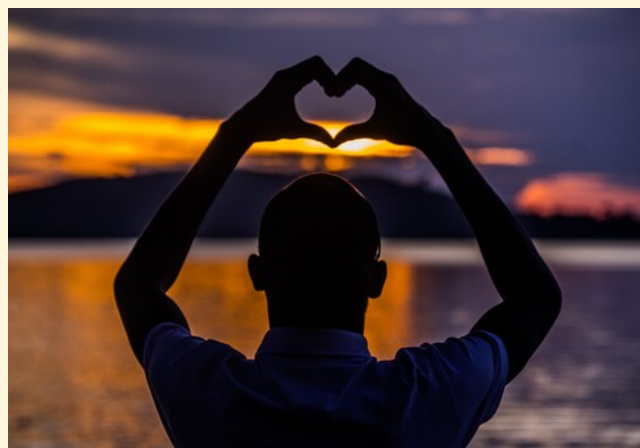
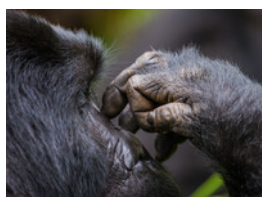
