


#### We're gonna make it a special wild ride!

#### **Mount Kilimanjaro**

Welcome to Tanzania! After landing at Kilimanjaro International Airport, we greet you warmly and make sure you're prepared for the journey ahead. Today you can expect a scenic hike on the slopes of legendary Kilimanjaro, through lush rainforest on your way to Mandara Hut at 2700 m. Along the trail, you may spot playful blue monkeys, colobus monkeys with their striking white tails, and a variety of tropical birds.

From Mandara Hut, if the weather is clear, you can enjoy beautiful views over the rolling foothills of Kilimanjaro, Uhuru peak and Mawenzi peak rising in the distance, and even the vast plains stretching toward Kenya.

If your schedule allows, we highly recommend extending your tour by one extra day and spending the night at Mandara Hut. You will have a gentler start of your trip, and more time to enjoy nature (including exploring the Maundi Crater).





Accommodation | Day 1 **Njiro Legacy** Hotel

Njiro Legacy is a locally owned, tranquil hotel in Arusha, combining comfort with warm Tanzanian hospitality. The hotel offers modern air-conditioned rooms with premium bedding. Facilities include a serene garden, outdoor pool, bar and restaurant serving local and and international cuisine. It's very well located for your safari departure.

#### **Lake Manyara National Park**

Almost everyone who visits Lake Manyara falls in love with this unique park. Lake Manyara is most famous for being one of the few parks in Africa where its lions climb trees. It's not unusual to look up into the branches of Lake Manyara's forest canopy and find yourself faceto-face with a lion (or even an entire pride).

Large populations of elephants and olive baboons are further highlights, while the backdrop to all wildlife sightings here is the dramatic Rift Valley escarpment which rises over the park's western boundary, or pretty Lake Manyara itself which dominates the east.











Hhando Coffee Lodge is just outside the Ngorongoro Conservation Area's Lodare Gate, and spreads across a 15-acre coffee farm. Wander through the farm and enjoy the deep-green views that stretch out across the highlands. The spacious bungalow-style rooms have warm color schemes and plenty of natural light. Relax in the swimming pool and the restaurant.

When you explore the Central Serengeti, you're enjoying one of the best wildlife destinations in northern Tanzania. Here you'll find the big populations of wildlife for which the Serengeti is famous. You'll also have a good chance of seeing big cats. This area has plenty of northern Tanzania's iconic acacia trees, as well as seemingly endless Serengeti horizons.

#### South Serengeti - Ndutu Plains. Calving Season

Off the main route between Ngorongoro and the Serengeti, and in the far south of the latter, Ndutu is a smaller-scale, more intimate version of one of Tanzania's best wildlife regions. It's a fabulous destination year-round, and this is where millions of wildebeest give birth to their calves when the great migration passes through, often with plenty of predators nearby. It also has all of the essential elements of the Serengeti's appeal, including big horizons and incredible wildlife, but without the crowds you'd share it with elsewhere.



Look out over the wildlife-rich plains of Ndutu in the Southern Serengeti at this wonderful classic safari camp with a luxurious touch and personalized service.

Big cats, young wildebeest that attract predators, zebra and other animals might wander past your tent at any moment and you may even hear lions roaring at night. The safari tents all face out across the grasslands, and there are lounge and dining tents where you can relax while in camp.

#### **Ngorongoro Crater**

Today you'll visit Ngorongoro Crater, one of the most beautiful natural sights in Africa, a place where you'll experience otherworldly beauty with extraordinary wildlife. Watch as, from above, morning mist rolls up and over the crater rim, and notice how the steep walls suggest a place unlike any other.

Down below on the crater floor, explore a lost world preserved in a state of pristine isolation, one that shelters lions and hyenas, elephants and black rhinos, flamingos and golden jackals. There are also forests, hippo-filled lakes, a salt pan and hyena dens, and you'll never lose the sense that you've stumbled into a safari theme park where everything's wild.


