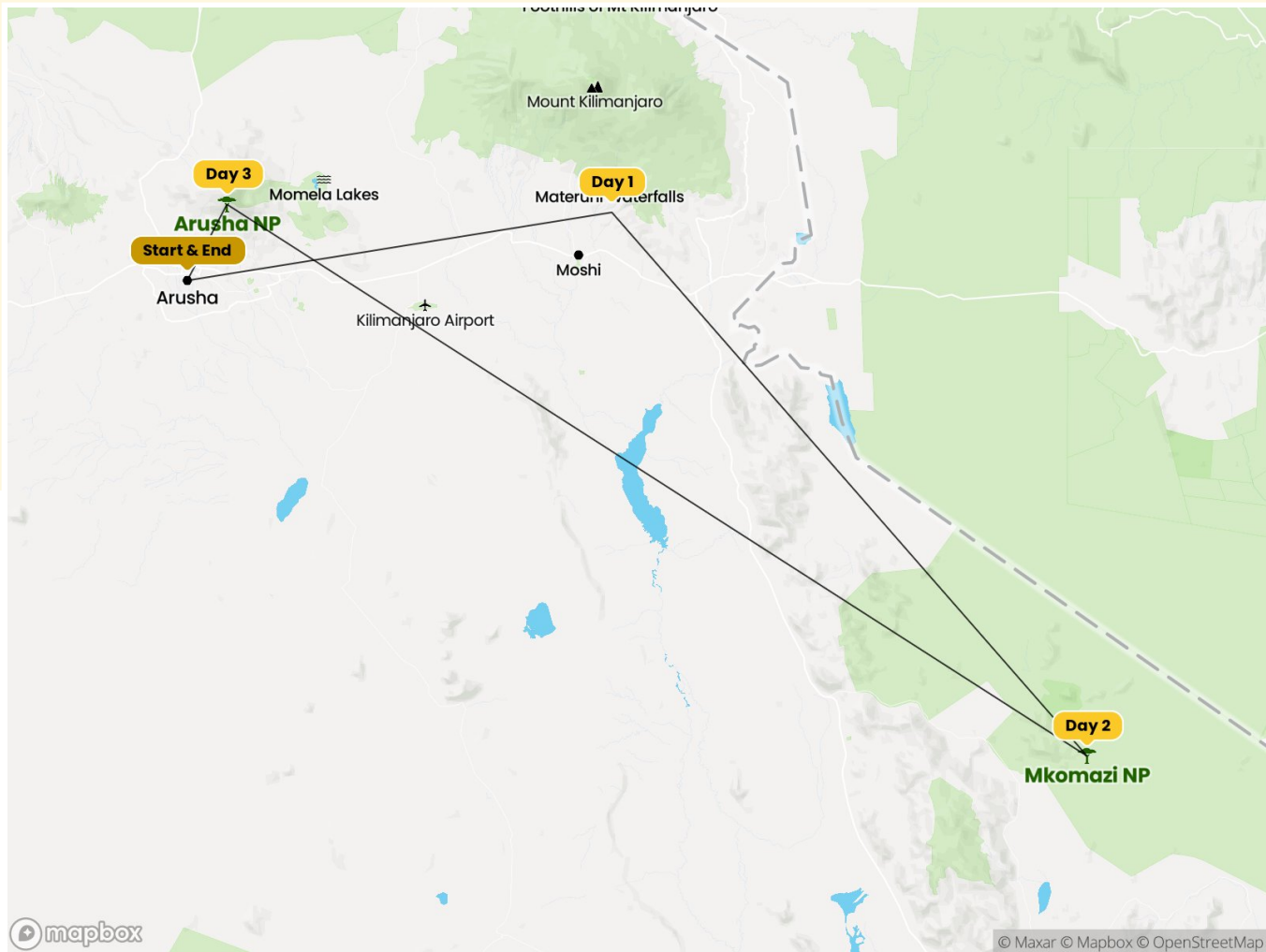

Day 1

Materuni Waterfalls. Rhino Sanctuary in Mkomazi

It's time to begin your safari. Welcome to Tanzania!

Start your day from Arusha, Moshi, or Kilimanjaro Airport, driving through lush foothills of Mount Kilimanjaro towards Materuni village. Enjoy a refreshing hike to Materuni Waterfalls, where you can take a dip in the crystal-clear mountain pool beneath the falls.

Visit a local Chagga coffee farm, learn how organic coffee is grown, roasted, and brewed traditionally, and savor a home-cooked Chagga lunch surrounded by banana groves.

In the afternoon, continue towards Mkomazi National Park, where the landscape shifts from green hills to open savanna. Visit the Rhino Sanctuary during the cooler hours, when rhinos come to the waterhole and are most active.

Conclude the day with a scenic game drive through the park's golden plains, watching the sun set behind Pare mountains — a perfect ending to a day full of nature, culture, and wildlife.

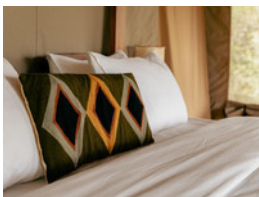

Accommodation | Day 1

Babu's Camp

Tented bush camp

You'll feel a part of nature when you sleep under canvas at Babu's Camp, which puts you in the perfect position to enjoy safari life.

Beautifully set among baobab and acacia trees, the six walk-in safari tents are comfortably furnished with a large wooden bed (or twin beds), wardrobe, changing area, safari chairs, and a writing desk. Each tent has an ensuite bathroom with a flush toilet and hot shower.

The large bar/mess area is beautifully situated on an outcrop with spectacular views of the Dindira valley and on clear mornings all the way to Mount Kilimanjaro.

Special attention has been paid to the aesthetic, both in the placement of the tents and the furnishings inside. The tent interiors reflect the land around them – soft earth tones, natural fabrics, stone, wood, and grass all used to create a peaceful, harmonious existence with nature.

In keeping with an environmentally friendly policy, each tent unit has a solar panel with a battery and inverter and all the bulbs are of the energy-saving type. Water for hot water showers is heated through a solar hot water system and is gravity fed to each tent.

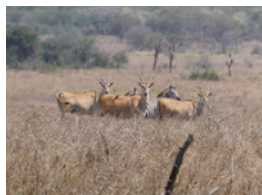
You'll enjoy the wildness of Mkomazi, from the baobabs and acacia trees to the lack of crowds, with good views of Pare Mountains and even Mt Kilimanjaro. When it comes to wildlife, elephants are increasingly a possibility – the return of elephants from across the border in Kenya is a wildlife success story. You might also see oryx, eland, kudu, Coke's hartebeest and the long-necked gerenuk while you're here. The park has also recorded more than 400 bird species.

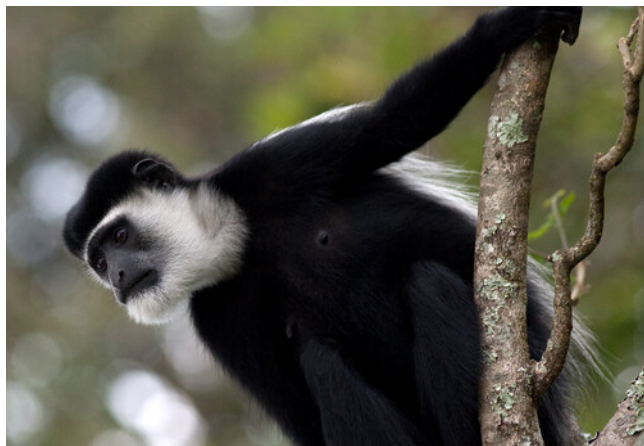
Arusha National Park

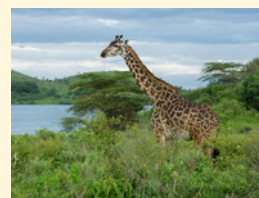
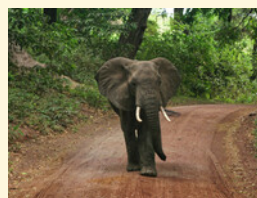
This brings your Tanzanian safari to a close – may the memories linger, and the call of the wild draw you back again.
