Do you want to see live theatre, talk about it with other teens, and learn more about your own taste in art? Our CTG Teen Theatregoers Program lets you choose the shows you want to see at Center Theatre Group (all for free!), and gets you in the room with theatre professionals who will help you learn how to think, talk, and experience live theatre like a pro.

The Teen Theatergoers Program embraces diversity and strives to provide greater access to live theatre performances to students from all backgrounds.

Program runs **December 2019 – May 2020** Apply by **3pm on Friday, November 1, 2019**

Participation is *FREE* and students will receive two tickets, one for themselves and one ticket for a guest for select performances.





PROGRAM INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY

Arts-interested high school students ages 14–18 who reside in Los Angeles County are eligible to apply. We're looking for teens who want to see and discuss live theatre with one another. No theatre experience is required!

LOCATION & TRANSPORTATION

Meetings take place at the Center Theatre Group offices located in The Music Center Annex, 601 W Temple St, Los Angeles, CA 90012, and performances take place at the Ahmanson Theatre and Mark Taper Forum, both located at 135 N Grand Avenue, Los Angeles, CA 90012; one performance option takes place at the Kirk Douglas Theatre located at 9820 Washington Blvd, Culver City, CA 90232.

TEEN THEATREGOERS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND:

Participants are required to attend four complimentary performances during the course of the program. The entire group will see *Jitney* by August Wilson at the Taper together, and participants will see three more performances of their choice on dates of their choice (subject to availability) at the Ahmanson, Taper and/or Kirk Douglas Theatres from December 2019 – May 2020.

Participants are required to attend the following meetings:

1) Opening Discussion, Lunch, and Performance of Jitney: Saturday, Dec 7, 2019, 12:30–5pm (includes performance time).

2) Mid-Point Discussion and Dinner: Thursday, Feb 20, 2020, 4:30-6:30pm (no performance).

3) Closing Discussion and Dinner: Tuesday, May 5, 2020, 4:30–6:30pm (no performance).

Students will receive one ticket for *Jitney* for December 7, 2019 plus two tickets for three additional performances for themselves and a guest of any age. The total time commitment is about 15 hours—most of it as an audience member!

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

1) Open the Application document using Adobe Reader (download for free at Abobe.com/Downloads).

2) Fill out all areas of the Application and save the document. **Note that signatures from you and your parent/guardian are required.** You can print the Application and scan it back into a computer if you're planning on submitting your application via email.

3) Answer the Personal Statement question in a separate document.

4) Send the signed Application and the Personal Statement (page 4).
