Night of IHSMTA Showcase (Thursday, May 29, 2025)

1. **Award Recipient Meeting:** Directly following the showcase, you and your family will be welcomed into the Stoner Theater for additional information. You will be directed there by program staff. Your family will be prompted to meet you there.

About the Camp:

There will be 72 high school students participating in the camp in three cohorts of up to 24 students.
