The Migrant Rights Initiative's Migrant Rights Database (MRD) is the first global data source benchmarking the extent to which states fulfill international obligations in national law, as reflected in the Initiative's International Migrants Bill of Rights (IMBR), and how they implement these protections. The database applies a novel instrument that permits the objective, cross-national accounting of the laws protecting migrants' rights enshrined in national legal frameworks.
