Commitment to Net Zero

UK Fuels are committed to achieving net zero emissions by 2050*.

*Our Net-Zero commitment is aligned with the scope of this reporting document. For the avoidance of doubt, this includes Scope 1, 2 and the required Scope 3 Categories (4,5,6,7,9). UK Fuels is a subsidiary company of the Radius Group. This Carbon Reduction Plan covers UK Fuels only.

Baseline emissions footprint

We are using FY25 (April 2024-March 2025) as the baseline year for reporting purposes.

Emissions reduction targets

We are targeting a 50% reduction in our Scope 1-2 emissions by 2035 in addition to our commitment to reaching Net-Zero by 2050.

Completed carbon reduction projects

We have completed the below projects in FY25.

Project	Context
Environmental Management System (EMS)	UK Fuels operates an EMS certified to ISO14001. This drives ongoing carbon reduction initiatives.
LED lighting installation	In addition to our sites in Crewe, we have installed new LED lights in two additional sites.
Transition to Electric Vehicles	We utilise two electric vans across our sites in Crewe.
Supporting employees to transition	We provide access to a Cycle to Work scheme and salary sacrifice Electric Vehicle scheme for eligible colleagues.

Future carbon reduction initiatives

We are working on additional carbon reduction initiatives, and plan to implement these over the upcoming years.

Project	Context
LED lighting installations	In FY26, we will continue to roll out our LED installation across our property portfolio. These improvements were identified as part of our Energy Saving Opportunity Scheme (ESOS) audit.

Solar PV	In FY26, the business will install our first solar panels at our global HQ in Crewe. This is forecasted to generate over 80,000 kWh of clean, renewable electricity every year.
Transition to Electric Vehicles	Over the coming years, we are aiming to move forward with further electrification of our corporate fleet.
Supporting Employees	We will continue to provide access to the Cycle to Work scheme and salary sacrifice Electric Vehicle scheme for eligible colleagues.
Climate Transition Plan and Sustainability Strategy	We are working on developing a Climate Transition Plan and broader Sustainability Strategy, which will set out detailed plans for how we will reduce our emissions across our wider Group operations.
