## National call charges

Call types which do not fall within the unlimited standard calls for Talk & Text Unlimited are as follows:

NGN (0800)	Free
NGN (all other numbers)	£0.46 (Access Charge)
Channel Islands, Isle of Man	£0.30 per minute

Due to Ofcom regulations, calls to NGNs (those beginning with 084, 087, 09 and 118) are made up of an Access Charge (set by your mobile provider) and a Service Charge (set by the organisation you are calling).

## International call charges

Calls to rest of world destinations	£1.50 per minute

## Roamed usage structure

Automatically utilise your UK voice and data tariff when using your mobile device abroad.

Europe zone - Free

- Unlimited free calls to standard mobile & landline numbers in country
- Unlimited free calls back to UK
- Access to full UK data bundle (Capped at 25GB)

The following applies to the roaming service:

- A day is counted from 00:00 to 23:59 local time of the country in which usage occurs.
- Incoming calls / text messages do not trigger the daily charge.
- Vodafone mandate that the Global Roamer service applies to all lines on an account.
- Network applied roamed caps and notifications do not apply.
- Roaming data access to 25GB for Unlimited data in Europe Zone 1 & 2. Once the 25GB of data has been exceeded within a month, further data usage will be charged £2.61 per GB to continue using data
