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Plain talk about risk

The trust is subject to the risks of its underlying funds. As the underlying funds invest in stocks and bonds the trust is subject to several stock and bond market risks, any of which could cause an investor to lose money. However, based on the trust's current allocation between stocks and the less volatile asset class of bonds, the trust's overall level of risk should be higher than those trusts that invest the majority of their assets in bonds, but lower than those investing entirely in stocks. As the trust's allocation among underlying funds gradually changes, the trust's overall level of risk also will decline. In addition to the risks inherent in the asset classes of the underlying funds, the trust asset allocation risk, which is the chance that the selection of underlying funds and the allocation of trust assets will cause the trust to underperform other trusts with a similar investment objective. Investments in target-date trusts are subject to the risks of their underlying funds. The year in the trust name refers to the approximate year when an investor in the trust would retire and leave the work force. The trust will gradually shift its emphasis from more aggressive investments to more conservative ones based on its target date.
