ATTENDEE REGISTRATION:

SPOUSE/GUEST REGISTATION:

The \$150 fee includes access to the awards luncheon, candidates forum, networking reception, Capitol connection breakfast and Cities United Day at the Capitol.

MONDAY DAY PASS:

The day pass includes the Capitol connection breakfast and Cities United Day at the Capitol. Transportation will be provided to and from the Capitol following breakfast. This option is not available as an add on to those taking training and/or attending policy committee meetings and/or the awards luncheon.

MUNICIPAL TRAINING INSTITUTE CLASSES:
